

Seconds That Mattered: The Bass Hospital Shooting Debrief

This operational debrief explores the active shooter response at Integris Bass Hospital in Enid, Oklahoma, where a suspect linked to a nearby domestic disturbance traveled to the hospital and opened fire, fatally wounding a public safety officer before being stopped by responding officers. Participants will analyze the timeline of events — from initial call to suspect engagement — and examine key law enforcement decisions, tactical considerations, interagency communication, containment strategies, and officer safety under duress. Drawing on official investigative details and response actions, this course highlights critical lessons learned for law enforcement professionals responding to violent incidents in complex civilian environments such as healthcare facilities. Emphasis will be placed on threat assessment, dynamic decision-making, coordinated tactics with hospital security, and strategies to protect civilians and other first responders.
