The Lethality Assessment Program (LAP) is a life-saving tool used across Oklahoma to identify high-risk victims of intimate partner violence and connect them with immediate support. This training covers domestic violence trends, the Oklahoma LAP protocol, and the importance of early, coordinated intervention. Participants will learn the research behind LAP, its statutory authority, and best practices for administering the protocol in a victim-centered way. Real case studies, including a domestic violence homicide, demonstrate how early risk identification can prevent future tragedies.
