

## COVID-19 Report Sep. 16, 2020

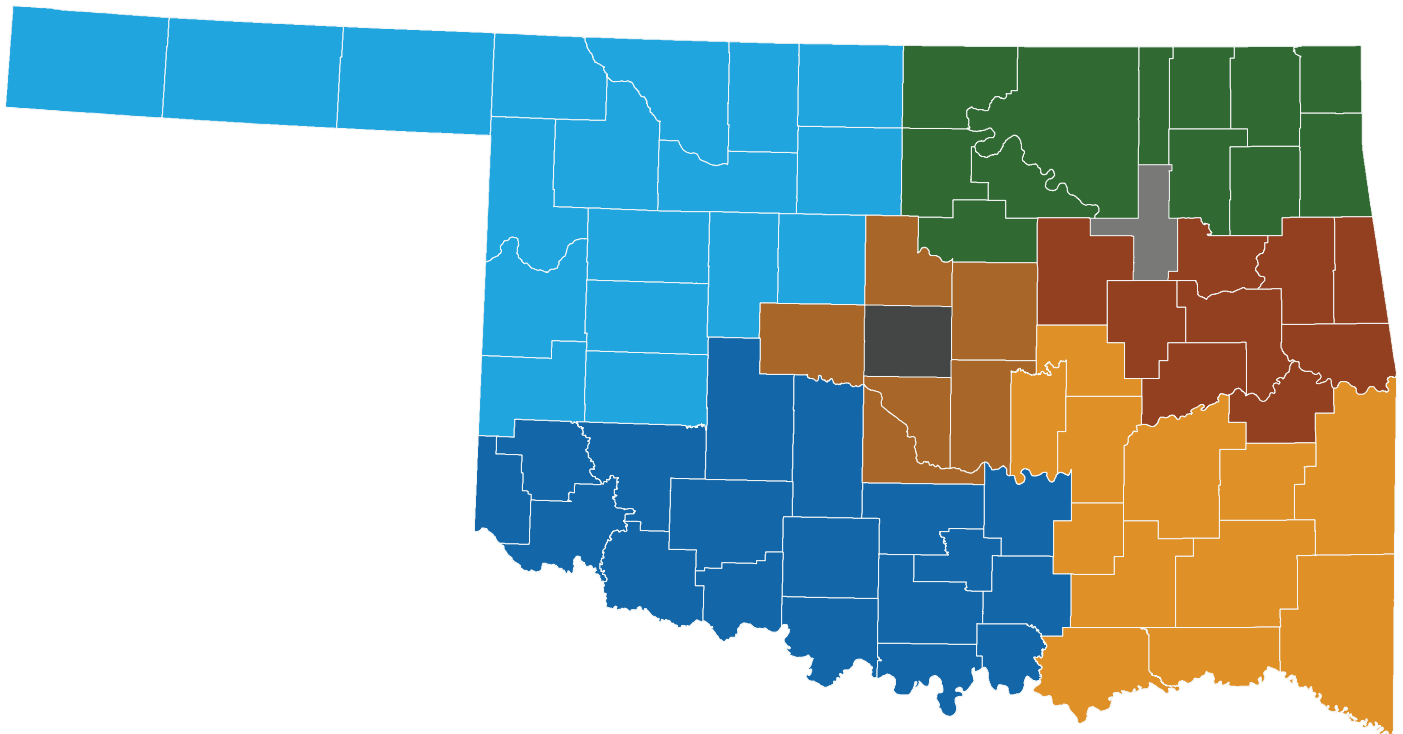
