The executive committee can approve conference support up to \$5,000. If the request is over \$5,000 for a conference, the proposal would go through committee first, then through Council. Ms. Fugitt asked a follow-up question, regarding if what was budgeted for conference support was spent, could proposals still be funded. Ms. Randle explained if there were funding. For example, if a project is underspending, we could unobligated funds in that project and obligate funds for the proposal.
