AGREED ORDER PERMANENTLY ENJOINING GLAMOUR WHITE, LLC. KYLE  
JOHNSON AND J.C. WILSON FROM THE PRACTICE OF DENTISTRY AND DISMISSING  
JOHN DOE 1-5 AND JANE DOE 1-5 WITH PREJUDICE

This matter has come before this Court pursuant to the agreement of Plaintiff, the State of Oklahoma ex rel. Oklahoma Board of Dentistry ("Board"), and Defendants, Glamour White, LLC, Kyle Johnson and J.C. Wilson (collectively, "Glamour White, Johnson and Wilson") that this Court should enter its order permanently enjoining Glamour White, Johnson and Wilson from the practice of dentistry in Oklahoma. The Board is represented by its counsel, Gretchen G. Harris, Assistant Attorney General, State of Oklahoma, and Defendants, Glamour White, Johnson and Wilson are represented by their counsel, Paul G. Summars.

Wherefore, having been fully advised as to the agreement of the parties and having reviewed the record, including the affidavits of Johnson and Wilson, this Court finds and orders as follows:

1. It is unlawful to practice dentistry or hold oneself out as a dentist in the State of Oklahoma without proper authorization from the Board. 59 O.S. §2001 & Supp. 2007 §328.49(A)(B).

2. Defendants, Johnson and Wilson admit that they do not possess a license to practice dentistry from the Board. Defendants, Johnson and Wilson have stipulated that they will not contest the allegations in this proceeding that they, through Glamour White, committed acts in violation of Section 328.19 (3) and (11) of the Oklahoma Dental Act ("Dental Act") in malls in Tulsa, Oklahoma, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma and Norman, Oklahoma by offering teeth whitening treatments as described in the Board's Petition for Temporary and Permanent Injunctive Relief.

3. Defendant, Glamour White, through its owners Johnson and Wilson, stipulate that it will not contest the allegations in this proceeding that it committed acts in violation of § 328.19 (3) and (11) of the Dental Act in malls in Tulsa, Oklahoma, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, and Norman, Oklahoma by offering teeth whitening treatments as described in the Board's Petition for Temporary and Permanent Injunctive Relief.

4. The Board of Dentistry has specific statutory authority to seek temporary and permanent injunctive relief. 59 O.S. §2001 & Supp. 2007 §328.49(D).

NOW THEREFORE, with the agreement of the Board, Glamour White, Johnson and Wilson,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Glamour White, Johnson and Wilson, each of their respective agents, servants and all persons acting by and under their authority or in concert with them, are hereby enjoined from performing the following activities:

- a. engaging in the practice of dentistry as such is defined by the acts set out at 59 O.S. 2001 & Supp. 2007 §328.19;

- b. providing teeth whitening products, services or treatment at shopping malls or any other location in the State of Oklahoma, including but not limited to providing any type of promotional material for teeth whitening, employing any persons to provide teeth whitening products, services or treatment in Oklahoma, providing any professional instructions for teeth whitening or offering or undertaking, by any means or methods, to remove stains or discolorations from the teeth in Oklahoma; and
- c. holding themselves out to be dentists, persons licensed to practice dentistry, or persons licensed or authorized by the Board to provide teeth whitening treatment;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Glamour White, Johnson and Wilson shall provide a copy of this Agreed Order, upon request, to each customer who received teeth whitening products, services or treatment from Glamour White and to each agent, employee, or person hired to perform teeth whitening product sales or treatments or services related to this Agreed Order;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that defendants, John Doe 1-5 and Jane Doe-1-5 are hereby dismissed with prejudice from the captioned action; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Order shall remain in full force and effect until further order of this Court, and that this Court retains jurisdiction of this matter for all purposes.



polishing, cleaning, or teeth whitening for their own personal use.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that all parties shall bear their own costs and attorney's fees.




