AGREED ORDER OF VOLUNTARY SURRENDER

This matter comes on for consideration before the Board of Dentistry, State of Oklahoma ("Board"), on November 7, 2003.

I <u>FINDINGS OF FACT</u>

Respondent Debora D. Landreth ("Respondent"), hereby agrees with the Board of Dentistry, State of Oklahoma, as follows:

- 1. Respondent holds Oklahoma Expanded Duty Permit No. 9379 issued May 27, 1994 for Radiation Safety.
- 2. Respondent holds Oklahoma Expanded Duty Permit No. 3094 issued April 12, 1996 for Coronal Polishing.
- 3. Respondent holds Oklahoma Expanded Duty Permit No. 472 issued May 9, 1996 for Nitrous Oxide.
- 4. Respondent is not presently employed as a dental assistant.
- 5. Respondent agrees that if evidence was presented, there is clear and convincing evidence the Respondent engaged in the practice dentistry by admitting she altered treatment plans of family and friends without the authorization or knowledge of her supervising dentist for the purpose of collecting additional funds from insurance claims, which were to be used to offset the patient's required deductible.
- 6. Respondent agrees that if evidence was presented, there is clear and convincing evidence the Respondent prescribed medications by admitting she called in to a pharmacy at least four (4) prescriptions for Vicodin (C-III) for her husband using the name and DEA number of her supervising dentist without his knowledge or authorization.

II CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board hereby finds and as evidenced by her signature appearing below, Respondent agrees and admits the following conclusions of law are true and correct:

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- The Board has jurisdiction of this matter by virtue of the provisions of the State Dental Act, 59 O.S. Supp 2000, Sec. 328.1 et seq.
- By virtue of the provisions of 59 O.S. Supp 2000, Sec. 328.15, the Board has the power and authority to promulgate rules to carry out the provisions of the State Dental Act as the Board deems necessary and proper to protect the dental health of the public.
- 3. By virtue of the provisions of 59 O.S. Supp 2000, Sec. 328.15(3), the Board is charged with enforcement of the provisions of the State Dental Act.
- 4. That the facts above and Board Findings constitute violations of Rules 195:15-1-5(2) and 195:15-1-5(3).

III VOLUNTARY SURRENDER

 Respondent will agree to voluntarily surrender her expanded duty permits for radiation safety, coronal polishing and nitrous oxide, immediately.

IT IS ORDERED AND AGREED that the expanded duty permits of DEBORA D. LANDRETH be voluntarily surrendered.

- 7. I understand that I may request permission to appear before the Board at the time the Board considers this Order.
- 8. I acknowledge and attest that no member of the Board, nor any employee, nor attorney of the Board, has coerced, intimidated, or pressured me, in any way whatsoever, to execute this Order.
- I understand this Order is not in force and effect and is not binding on the Board unless and until adopted by the Board and executed by the Board's President.
- 10. I understand that this Order shall not be amended or changed unless specifically authorized by the Board of Dentistry in an open meeting.
