RESULTS

Below are the results from the first round of testing of drinking water for lead that was conducted at Community Action Agency of Oklahoma City - New Heights Head Start on August 21, 2024. Overall, eleven (11) outlets were tested resulting in a total of twenty-two (22) samples being sent to the lab.

- Twenty-two (22) samples had no detectable level of lead.
- Zero (0) samples had a low detection of lead between 1.0 and 14.9 μ g/L.
- Zero (0) samples had a high detection of lead equal to or above 15.0 μg/L.
