Dear Mr. Meriwether:

On August 27, 2025, the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (“DEQ”) received the above-referenced Class 3, Tier III Permit Modification Request (“Application”) dated August 20, 2025, from Clean Harbors Lone Mountain, LLC (“CHLM”) for an expansion of CHLM’s container management building at its hazardous waste landfill facility in Waynoka, OK. Additional information was submitted on September 25 and October 1, 2025.

In accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 270.42(c), a notice of the modification request was published in the *Fairview Republican* on September 4, 2025, commencing a 60-day public comment period. A public meeting was held by the facility on September 25, 2025, which concurrently served as the process meeting described in 27A O.S. § 2-14-301(B); therefore, DEQ was in attendance to answer any questions regarding the permitting process. The 60-day public comment period ended on November 3, 2025. No public comments were received.

DEQ reviewed the Application for administrative and technical adequacy and found it to be administratively complete on November 20, 2025, commencing the technical review. DEQ found the Application to be technically complete and issued a preliminary courtesy draft of the Class 3, Tier III Permit Modification on January 20, 2026, for CHLM’s review and comment. CHLM had no comments on the courtesy draft.

DEQ has enclosed a draft Class 3, Tier III Permit Modification for public review and comment. Also enclosed are the newspaper and radio notices to be published and broadcast. CHLM is required to publish notice of opportunity to comment and request a public meeting on the Draft Permit Modification in at least one (1) local newspaper of general circulation. CHLM must also send the notice to all persons on the facility mailing list as specified in 40 C.F.R. § 124.10(c)(1)(viii). Concurrently, a notice should be broadcast on a local radio station. These notices will announce the opening of a forty-five (45) day comment period.

A fact sheet is also included for public information. Please ensure a copy of the Draft Permit Modification and fact sheet is made available at the Fairview Public Library; a copy will also be available at the DEQ office and on DEQ's website at <https://oklahoma.gov/deq/permits/land-permits/permit-public-participation-process.html>.

Modify the permit to authorize an expansion of an existing container management building. The proposed expansion will allow Clean Harbors Lone Mountain, LLC (“CHLM”) to increase the volume of waste to be stored and managed at the CHLM facility in Waynoka, OK. The expansion will result in a 50% increase in storage capacity and is classified as a Class 3, Tier III permit modification in accordance with Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (“40 C.F.R.”) § 270.42 and Oklahoma Administrative Code 252:4-7-54(2).

2. Clean Harbors Lone Mountain, LLC, must comply with 40 C.F.R., the Oklahoma Hazardous Waste Management Act and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, and all conditions of the Hazardous Waste Operations Permit. Any noncompliance

constitutes a violation of the Hazardous Waste Permit and is grounds for enforcement action, including: permit modification, administrative civil penalties, suspension or revocation, and denial of a pending permit modification application.

Basis of the Draft Permit Modification

On August 27, 2025, the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (“DEQ”) received a Class 3, Tier III RCRA Permit Modification request dated August 20, 2025, from Clean Harbors Lone Mountain, LLC (“CHLM”) for an expansion of the CHLM existing Container Management Building which is permitted to store various types of hazardous waste as listed in CHLM’s Waste Analysis Plan. Additional information was submitted on September 25, October 1, and December 19, 2025. After review, DEQ has determined that it is appropriate to tentatively approve the modification request and issue a Draft Permit Modification for public review and comment.

The basic requirements of the Oklahoma Hazardous Waste Management Act (“OHWMA”); the Oklahoma Administrative Code Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (OAC 252:205) as amended; the Federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (“RCRA”); and the federal hazardous waste regulations have been met, and DEQ has prepared the Draft Permit Modification.

The Draft Permit Modification incorporates applicable conditions from OAC 252:205 and Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (“40 C.F.R.”) Part 270, and other such conditions as are required to achieve environmentally sound hazardous waste management.

The administrative record supporting the potential Permit modification conditions consists of the Class 3, Tier III Permit Modification Application, additional supporting documentation, the Draft Permit Modification, and this Fact Sheet. The administrative record will be supplemented with any comments received during the public comment period.

Comment Period and Procedures

Persons wishing to comment on the Draft Permit Modification may submit their comments in writing to the agency at the address listed below or via DEQ’s website listed above. DEQ will consider and formally respond to all relevant comments in the issuance of a proposed Permit modification. Comments should be directed to the appropriateness of the permit modification decision and the permit modification conditions and should be of a factual nature. All comments must be received at the agency no later than forty-five (45) days after publication of notice of the Draft Permit Modification. Comments should be directed to:

The applicable comment and public hearing procedures may be found in OAC 252:4 and 40 C.F.R. Part 124. The comment period during which written comments on the Draft Permit Modification may be submitted extends for forty-five (45) days from the date of notice of the proposed action.

Public Meeting

Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. Part 124 and the Uniform Permitting Act, Title 27A of Oklahoma Statutes, Section 2-14-303, interested parties may request a public meeting on the Draft Permit Modification. The request must be in writing and submitted prior to the closing date of the comment period which expires forty-five (45) days from the date of publication. Persons wishing to request a public meeting should submit their request and/or comments in writing to Hillary Young, Chief Engineer, Land Protection Division at the above address no later than forty-five (45) days after publication.

If no comments are received during the comment period, a Proposed Permit Modification will be issued. At that time, notice of the Proposed Permit Modification will be published in a newspaper local to the site offering a 20-day opportunity to request an administrative hearing. The opportunity to request a hearing shall be available to the applicant and any person or qualified interest group who claims to hold a demonstrable environmental interest and who alleges that the construction or operation of the proposed facility or activity would directly and adversely affect such interest.

Notice of Final Determination

DEQ will notify the applicant and each person who has submitted written comments or requested notice of the final Permit modification decision. Within thirty (30) days after a RCRA Permit Modification decision has been issued, any person who filed comments on the Draft Permit Modification or participated in the public meeting/hearing may petition the Executive Director of DEQ to review any condition of the decision. The petition shall include a statement of the reasons supporting that review, including a demonstration that any issues being raised were raised during the public comment period, and when appropriate, a showing that the condition in question is based on a finding of fact or conclusion of law which is clearly erroneous or an exercise of discretion or important policy consideration which DEQ should review. A petition to DEQ is a prerequisite to judicial review under OAC 252:205-3-2 and OAC 252:205-3-5, which incorporates 40 C.F.R. § 124.19, and should be directed to the address listed below:

The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (“DEQ”) has reviewed a Class 3, Tier III permit modification request (“Application”) submitted by Clean Harbors Lone Mountain, LLC, for the expansion of its container management building at its commercial hazardous waste treatment, storage, and disposal facility located in the South Half (S/2) of Section 28, the North Half (N/2) of Section 33, the North Half (N/2), Southeast Quarter (SE/4) of Section 33, Township 23 North, Range 15 West, Indian Meridian, Major County, Oklahoma. DEQ has made a tentative determination to approve the permit modification application and has issued a Draft Permit Modification for public review and comment.

The Draft Permit Modification and its conditions propose that Clean Harbors Lone Mountain modify its permit to authorize an expansion of its container management building. The proposed expansion will allow an increase in the volume of waste to be stored and managed at the facility by 50%. The permit modification, if made final, would be issued under the authority of the Oklahoma Hazardous Waste Management Act and the federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.
