On August 27, 2025, the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (“DEQ”) received the above-referenced Class 3, Tier III Permit Modification Request (“Application”) dated August 20, 2025, from Clean Harbors Lone Mountain, LLC (“CHLM”) for an expansion of CHLM’s container management building at its hazardous waste landfill facility in Waynoka, OK. Additional information was submitted on September 25, October 1, and December 19, 2025.

In accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 270.42(c), a notice of the modification request was published in the *Fairview Republican* on September 4, 2025, commencing a 60-day public comment period. A public meeting was held by the facility on September 25, 2025, which concurrently served as the process meeting described in 27A O.S. § 2-14-301(B); therefore, DEQ was in attendance to answer any questions regarding the permitting process. The 60-day public comment period ended on November 3, 2025. No public comments were received.

DEQ reviewed the Application for administrative and technical adequacy and found it to be administratively complete on November 20, 2025, and technically complete on January 20, 2026, on which date a preliminary courtesy draft of the Class 3, Tier III Permit Modification was issued for CHLM review and comment. CHLM had no comments on the courtesy draft.

On March 4, 2026, DEQ issued a Draft Class 3, Tier III Permit Modification for public review and comment. The Draft included language for the newspaper and radio notices to be published and broadcast. CHLM broadcasted the notice on KWOX-FM on March 16, 2026, and published in the *Fairview Republican* on March 19, 2026, followed by a republication on April 2, 2026, commencing a 45-day public comment period. The public comment period ended on May 17, 2026, and no public comments were received.


DEQ has prepared the enclosed Proposed Class 3, Tier III Permit Modification for public review. In accordance with Title 252, Chapter 4, Appendix C of the Oklahoma Administrative Code (“OAC”) and the Oklahoma Hazardous Waste Management Act, 27A O.S. § 2-14-304, CHLM must publish notice of a 20-day opportunity to request an administrative hearing. The

The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (“DEQ”) hereby approves the following modification:

Modification:

Modify the permit to authorize an expansion of an existing container management building. The proposed expansion will allow Clean Harbors Lone Mountain, LLC (“CHLM”) to increase the volume of waste to be stored and managed at the CHLM facility in Waynoka, OK. The expansion results in a 50% increase in storage capacity and was classified as a Class 3, Tier III permit modification in accordance with Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (“40 C.F.R.”) § 270.42 and Oklahoma Administrative Code 252:4-7-54(2).

Any inaccuracies found in the Application or supporting documentation may provide cause for potential enforcement action against Clean Harbors Lone Mountain, LLC, and the amendment, modification, or revocation of this permit modification.
2. Clean Harbors Lone Mountain, LLC, must comply with 40 C.F.R., the Oklahoma Hazardous Waste Management Act and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, and all conditions of the Hazardous Waste Operations Permit. Any noncompliance

constitutes a violation of the Hazardous Waste Permit and is grounds for enforcement action, including: permit modification, administrative civil penalties, suspension or revocation, and denial of a pending permit modification application.

The permittee is authorized to operate in conformity with the documents incorporated by reference. Commencing operations under this modification constitutes acceptance of, and consent to, the conditions contained herein.

Basis of the Proposed Permit Modification

On August 27, 2025, the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (“DEQ”) received a Class 3, Tier III RCRA Permit Modification request dated August 20, 2025, from Clean Harbors Lone Mountain, LLC (“CHLM”) for an expansion of the CHLM existing Container Management Building which is permitted to store various types of hazardous waste as listed in CHLM’s Waste Analysis Plan. Additional information was submitted on September 25, October 1, and December 19, 2025. After review, DEQ tentatively approved the modification request and issued a Draft Permit Modification on March 4, 2026, for public review and comment. CHLM broadcasted and published public notices on March 16 and March 19, 2026, respectively, followed by a republication on April 2, 2026. The 45-day public comment period ended on May 17, 2026, and no public comments were received.

The applicable requirements of the Oklahoma Hazardous Waste Management Act (“OHWMA”); the Oklahoma Administrative Code Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (OAC 252:205) as amended; the Federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (“RCRA”); and the federal hazardous waste regulations have been met, and DEQ has prepared a Proposed Permit Modification.

The Proposed Permit Modification incorporates applicable conditions from OAC 252:205 and Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (“40 C.F.R.”) Part 270 and other such conditions as are required to achieve environmentally sound hazardous waste management.

The administrative record supporting the Proposed Permit Modification conditions consists of the Class 3, Tier III Permit Modification Application, additional supporting documentation, the Draft Permit Modification, the Proposed Permit Modification, and this Fact Sheet.

Administrative Hearing Request Period and Procedures

Persons wishing to request an administrative hearing on the Proposed Permit Modification must submit their requests in writing via certified mail to the agency at the address listed below. The opportunity to request a hearing shall be available to the applicant and any person or qualified interest group who claims to hold a demonstrable environmental interest and who alleges that the construction or operation of the proposed facility or activity would directly and adversely affect such interest. All requests for an administrative hearing must be received by the agency no later than twenty (20) days after publication of notice of the Proposed Permit Modification. All requests for individual proceedings must be in writing, contain a brief statement of the basis of the request, the name and address of each requester, and be signed by the requester or an authorized representative. The applicable administrative hearing procedures may be found in OAC 252:4 and 27A O.S. § 2-14-304.

Notice of Final Determination

If no requests for an administrative hearing are timely received, DEQ shall issue the permit modification as final. Upon final issuance or denial of the permit modification application, DEQ shall provide public notice of the final permit modification decision. Within thirty (30) days after a RCRA Permit Modification decision has been issued, any person who filed comments on the Draft Permit Modification or participated in the public meeting/hearing may petition the Executive Director of DEQ to review any condition of the decision. The petition shall include a statement of the reasons supporting that review, including a demonstration that any issues being raised were raised during the public comment period, and when appropriate, a showing that the condition in question is based on a finding of fact or conclusion of law which is clearly erroneous or an exercise of discretion or important policy consideration which DEQ should review.

A petition to DEQ is a prerequisite to judicial review under OAC 252:205-3-2 and OAC 252:205-3-5, which incorporates 40 C.F.R. § 124.19, and should be directed to the address listed below:

OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY NOTICE OF PROPOSED PERMIT MODIFICATION FOR AN EXISTING HAZARDOUS WASTE TREATMENT, STORAGE AND DISPOSAL FACILITY

The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (“DEQ”) hereby gives notice of opportunity for interested parties to review and request an administrative hearing on a proposed hazardous waste permit modification prepared by DEQ. If no request is timely made, the proposed permit modification will become final.

DEQ reviewed a Class 3, Tier III permit modification request (“Application”) submitted by Clean Harbors Lone Mountain, LLC, for the expansion of its container management building at its commercial hazardous waste treatment, storage, and disposal facility located in the South Half (S/2) of Section 28, the North Half (N/2) of Section 33, the North Half (N/2) Southeast Quarter (SE/4) of Section 33, Township 23 North, Range 15 West, Indian Meridian, Major County, Oklahoma. The street address for the facility is 40355 South County Road 236, Waynoka, OK 73860.

DEQ prepared the Proposed Permit Modification after it reviewed the Application for compliance with the Hazardous Waste Management Act, Title 27A of the Oklahoma Statutes, Sections 2-7-101 through 2-7-134, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, and the rules of DEQ, Oklahoma Administrative Code (“OAC”) Title 252, Chapters 4 and 205; prepared a draft permit; and received no public comments or request for a public meeting.

An administrative hearing is an evidentiary individual proceeding held at DEQ's office by an administrative law judge in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act (Oklahoma Statutes, Title 75, Section 250 *et seq.*) and DEQ procedures (OAC Title 252, Chapter 4). If held, the hearing will determine: (1) if the proposed permit should/should not be issued as final and (2) if it is finalized, which, if any, of its conditions should be changed prior to issuance.

An administrative hearing can be requested by a person (or a qualified interest group that has 25 or more members who are Oklahoma residents) who claims to hold a demonstrable environmental interest and who alleges that the construction or operation of the proposed facility or activity would directly and adversely affect such interest. Each requester must participate in the hearing as a party and has a right to present testimony and evidence and cross-examine witnesses about the testimony and evidence presented by the applicant's attorney. An individual may represent himself or be represented by an attorney.

A request for an administrative hearing must be received by DEQ within 20 days after the date this notice is published. The request must be submitted in writing via certified mail to the Administrative Hearing Clerk, Department of Environmental Quality, P.O. Box 1677, Oklahoma City, OK 73101-1677. All requests for individual proceedings must be in writing, containing a brief statement of the basis of the request, the name and address of each requester, and be signed by the requester or an authorized representative. For more information on hearing procedures, see Title 27A of the Oklahoma Statutes Section 2-14-304, Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes Section 309, and OAC Title 252, Chapter 4, Rules of Practice and Procedure of the DEQ, Subchapter 9.
