




## Accessing nForm




## Registration

Click "Register" to create a new account.




Provide the required information and create a password. You will receive an email with a confirmation link and a confirmation code. Use either the link or the code to confirm your account.

When you sign in, you'll be prompted to complete your profile. **If you will be signing forms electronically, you will need to do this**. If you will only be preparing forms, then you can skip this step.




Provide address information. On the next screen, choose "Enable Electronic Signatures"




Create all five challenge questions and answers. Once you've saved your answers, they cannot be changed without contacting DEQ.

Once you have created your challenge questions and answers, choose "Use Digital Authentication Service."


If the system is unable to verify you, you will need to use the mail-in form.



Read the Electronic Subscriber Terms and Conditions carefully (a copy can be saved for your records) and click Continue.



Your identity will be verified through the LexisNexus Service. Make sure your are using your legal name. If it is unable to verify you on the first attempt, you may need to use a previous address or phone number.



Once the form has been submitted, you will receive a confirmation email. You will still need to pay an application fee for your form to be processed.
