

PROGRAM NEEDS MATRIX

Education/Employment

All inmates with the exception of those identified in [OP-060203](#) entitled “Adjustment Review” will complete a Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE) survey at the first facility following reception. Educational program needs will be identified per [OP-090107](#) entitled “Inmate Education Program” and entered on the “Case Plan” ([Attachment B](#)) upon arrival at the first receiving facility after transfer from the reception center.

Career Readiness assessments will be administered at reception centers. Assessment results and TABE survey scores will be utilized at the first facility following reception to determine employment needs. Enrollment into vocational technical training will be within the required time frames and in accordance with [OP-090133](#) entitled “Career and Technical Training.”

Cognitive Behavioral (COG)

Inmates scoring a 19+ overall (moderate risk or higher) on the Level of Service Inventory Revised (LSI-R) assessment **and** a .50 or higher in the Attitudes and Orientations subscale of the LSI-R will be identified as a case plan need for cognitive behavioral programming. Projected enrollment for purposes of the “Case Plan” ([Attachment B](#)) will be upon transfer from the reception center.

Alcohol/Drug (SAT) (4-ACRS-5A-08)

Inmates scoring a 19+ overall (moderate risk or higher) on the LSI-R assessment **and** a .50 or higher in the Alcohol/Drug LSI-R subscale **or** 21 or higher in the Disruption subscale of the Adult Substance Use Survey (ASUS) will be identified as a case plan need for substance abuse treatment. Projected enrollment for purposes of the “Case Plan” ([Attachment B](#), attached) will be upon transfer from the reception center.
