

## GPS PROGRAM CRITERIA

### **ELIGIBILITY:**

- Incarcerated in an ODOC facility for at least 90 days
- Currently assigned to a community facility for a minimum of 30 days
- Must have a valid home offer, homeless shelters are not acceptable
- Must be able to furnish a telephone or if required, have telephone equipment and service that supports the monitoring technology
- Must be approved for placement by medical
- Must have approval from MHA if Mental Health Level is C1
- Must be assigned to Earned Credit Level 2 or higher
- Must have negative drug test immediately prior to placement
- Must be serving a sentence of 5 years or less and initial placement not higher than minimum security level or;
- Must have no more than the following days remaining:

### **EXCLUSIONARY CRITERIA:**

- Conviction for violent offense within previous 10 years or a current incarceration for a violent offense or convicted of a violent offense within the previous ten years.
- Inmates convicted of any violation of the Trafficking in Illegal Drugs Act, Section 2-414 et. seq. of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- Inmates denied parole within the previous 12 months pursuant to Section 332.7 of Title 57 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- Inmates convicted pursuant to Section 11-902 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes who are not receptive to substance abuse treatment and follow-up treatment.
- Inmates ever removed from the GPS program, or any other alternative to incarceration program authorized by law, for violation of any rule or condition of the program and reassigned to imprisonment in a correctional facility.
- Inmates deemed by the department to be a security risk or a threat to the public.
- Inmates requiring educational, medical, or other services or programs not available in a community setting as determined by the department.
- Inmates convicted of any violation of subsection C of Section 644 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes or who have an active protection order that was issued under the Protection from Domestic Abuse Act, Section 60 through 60.16 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- Inmates who have outstanding felony warrants or detainers (to include misdemeanor detainers properly lodged with the Department of Corrections) from another jurisdiction (federal, state, county or municipal).
- Inmates convicted of a sex offense who, upon release from incarceration, would be required by law to register pursuant to the Sex Inmate Registration Act.
- Inmates convicted of racketeering activity as defined in Section 1402 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- Inmates convicted pursuant to Section 650 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- Inmates who have escaped from a penal or correctional institution within the previous ten (10) years.
- Inmates who currently have active misconducts (class A or B within the previous six months or class X within the previous two years).
- No serious misconducts.
