**MEDICAL ACUITY REFERENCE GUIDE**

<b>MEDICAL ACUITY</b>	<b>Medical Acuity</b>
Normal physical condition or mild disease (compensated medical condition)	<b>MAA</b>
Moderate (may require more frequent visits)	<b>MAB</b>
Severe (requires frequent monitoring, illness exacerbations, referral to specialty care, infirmary or hospital base care)	<b>MAC</b>

<b>DISCRETIONARY OVERRIDE TO SPECIFIC FACILITY WHERE ALLOWED BY SECURITY LEVEL</b>	<b>Group</b>
No override recommendations	<b>O</b>
W/C Bound (non-ambulatory)	<b>WB</b>
W/C (able to ambulate short distances without assistance)	<b>W</b>
Requires: Handicap accommodations	<b>H</b>
Pregnancy	<b>P</b>
Chronic hemodialysis or peritoneal dialysis	<b>D</b>
TB disease: needs isolation cell at Infirmary	<b>TB</b>
Blind	<b>BL</b>
Requires inmate caregiver 1	<b>CA1</b>
Requires inmate caregiver 2	<b>CA2</b>
Restricted to current facility	<b>CF</b>
Requires infirmary care	<b>INF</b>
Requires facility with medical staff on-site 24 hours a day	<b>NC</b>
Requires facility with on-site medical care – <b>No</b> Halfway Houses	<b>OMC</b>
No private prisons	<b>NP</b>
MH-B1: <b>NO county jail placement (exception – can go to exiting facility)</b>	<b>MHB1</b>
MH-B2: <b>NO county jail placement. Recommend override to facilities with one or more QMHP and weekly psychiatric visits. (exception – can go to exiting facility)</b>	<b>MHB2</b>
MH-C1: <b>NO county jail placement.</b> Should have mental health staff approval for other than medium or maximum security.	<b>MHC1</b>
MH-C2: <b>NO county jail placement.</b> Meets criteria for Habilitation Program: Recommend JHCC or MBCC	<b>MHC2</b>
MH-D: <b>NO county jail placement.</b> Recommend MHU at JHCC, or MBCC	<b>MHD</b>
