GOVX.COM: Free online membership website for Military, Law Enforcement, and Government Employees. Website provides discounts on Merchandise, Services, Tech, Travel, and Entertainment to include premium cable channels, theme parks, concerts, music festivals, shows, movies, and sports events.

ID.me: ID.me helps you prove your identity and group affiliation across multiple websites. It serves the same purpose as the physical ID cards you carry in your wallet – but for the internet.

Sheerid.com: works with leading B2C brands in retail, streaming, software, hospitality, and finance to connect with consumer tribes like the military and students with gated, personalized offers. Each offer is exclusive, which encourages members to share it with others in their network, increasing reach, and decreasing acquisition costs.

VerifyPass.com: Offers discounts to merchandise, services, and entertainment for military, first responders, medical professionals, teachers, students, and select business partners.

Bates Footwear: First responders save 15% off any order.
