1.1 The undersigned, being familiar with the local conditions affecting the cost of the work, with the Solicitation for Bids and in accordance with the provisions thereof, hereby proposes to furnish all labor, materials and equipment necessary for the sums listed herein.

1.2 In submitting the bid, it is understood that the right is reserved by the State of Oklahoma to reject any and all bids, and it is agreed that this bid may not be withdrawn for a period of thirty (30) days after the date bids are due. Work is to start within ten (10) days after receipt of Notice to Proceed.

ARTICLE 2: Compliance.

2.1 The Bidder certifies that:

2.1.1 they are an Equal Employment Opportunity Employer and that they do not discriminate in any of their business or employment practices;

2.1.2 they, and all sub-contractors and suppliers performing work on the Project, will comply with the provisions of the Oklahoma Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act of 2007 and participate in the Status Verification System. The Status Verification System is defined in the Oklahoma Statutes, Title 25 §1312;

2.1.3 they will comply with the laws relating to public construction in the Oklahoma Statutes (Title 61) and the Oklahoma Administrative Code (Section 260, Chapter 65); and

2.1.4 they will comply with all State of Oklahoma Governor's Executive Orders, including those relating to the prohibited use of any and all tobacco product on any and all properties owned, leased or contracted for use by the State of Oklahoma, including but not limited to all buildings, land and vehicles owned, leased or contracted for use by agencies or instrumentalities of the State of Oklahoma.

ARTICLE 3: Bid Proposal:

This is the bid specifications for the carport on the east side of building # 6 located at the DPS/OHP headquarters 3600 N MLK Ave. OKC, OK. 73111

1. Awning Dimensions and description:

- a. The carport dimensions are 80 ft. X 16 ft.
- b. Attach to the existing building.
- c. Materials are to be metal.
- d. Car port is to be open on the three sides other than where attached to the existing building.
- e. Poles to be concreted a minimum of 24" into the ground or mounted on piers 24" deep and 12" in diameter with 18" long anchors embedded in concrete piers.
- f. All poles and rafter materials to be coated (no bare metal).
- g. Any areas that are welded need to be painted with primer to keep from rusting.
- h. Sheet metal to be attached to framing with hex-head self-tapping rubber washers type screws.
- i. Where the carport attaches to the existing building a flashing must be used to keep water leaks from entering between the building and carport.

2. Color:

- a. The sheet metal roof must be white in color.
- b. No color will be specified for framing so long as it is all a matching color.

3. Start and Completion Time.

- a. The start date shall be within 10 days of the award of bid.
- b. The completion date shall be within 14 days from the start date. (Exception due to inclement weather).
- c. DPS will need to be notified 3 days prior if work is going to be performed after DPS's normal working hours or weekend/holidays. (Normal working hours are 7:30am to 4:45 PM M-F).

4. DPS will require a current up to date copy of the company's liability insurance and workman comp. on file before being awarded the project.

5. DPS will require a written 1-year warranty on workmanship, and a certificate of the manufactures warranty on sheet metal goods.

6. Cleaning of DPS property.

- a. It will be it responsibility of the Building contractor to pick up the construction site daily.
- b. The construction site shall be clean of all debris, excess dirt, and discarded metal and screws upon completion of the job.
- c. Any bare metal on framing of building must be primed or painted with a like color to protect from future rust.

7. Inspections.

- a. DPS has the right to make inspection at any time throughout the project.
- b. DPS and a representative of the contractor will perform a final inspection at the completion of the job. Vendor shall make any required repairs found to make the job complete.

Contractor to furnish all necessary Project Management, Superintendence, labor, machinery, equipment, tools, materials, supplies, and appurtenances to complete all the Work upon which is within these Contract Documents. Any required overtime and similar costs to complete the Project within the above stated days, is included.
