Instructions to the Requestor:

Upon approved request, an Oklahoma Highway Patrol Trooper will be in contact with you to set up a time for your vehicle inspection. The vehicle to be inspected must be on a cleared space (such as in a garage or hard surface) and easily accessible for the Trooper. The Trooper may request accommodations, such as but not limited to; the vehicle being on a lift or taken to a place that it can be placed on a lift. The Trooper can decline an inspection, at any time if he feels the vehicle is in an inaccessible location. After the inspection is complete, you will be emailed a letter stating the result of the inspection.

Supporting Statute for Requests:

Out of State Registration

Title 47 Chp.74 § 1105 (M), No title for any out-of-state vehicle offered for sale at salvage pools, salvage disposal sales, or an auction, or by a dealer or a licensed automotive dismantler and parts recycler, shall be issued without an inspection to compare the vehicle identification number on the vehicle with the number recorded on the ownership record and to record the actual odometer reading on the vehicle. Upon request of the seller, person or entity conducting an auction, dealer or licensed dismantler, the inspection shall be conducted at the location or place of business of the sale, auction, dealer, or the dismantler. The inspection shall be conducted by any motor license agent or a duly authorized employee thereof; provided, if the vehicle identification number on the vehicle offered for sale at salvage pools, salvage disposal sales or a classic or antique auction does not match the number recorded on the ownership record, the inspection may be conducted at the location of or place of business of such sale or auction by **any state, county or city law enforcement officer.**

Authority to law enforcement agencies

Title 47 Chp.2 § 2-117 (F), Nothing in this section shall limit a member of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol Division from requesting assistance from any other law enforcement agency nor limit officers of such agency from rendering the requested assistance. The officer and the law enforcement agency responding to the request of the member of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol Division or sheriff's department shall have the same rights and immunities as are possessed by the Oklahoma Highway Patrol Division.
