As a result of passage of SB19 and its effective date of November 1, 2019, the administrative rule changes are to provide the public holding an Oklahoma credential (driver license or identification card) or potential Oklahoma credential applicants clarification on the Department of Public Safety's proof of identification requirements to obtain an Oklahoma REAL ID Compliant or REAL ID Non-Compliant credential.
