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INSTRUCTIONS

All applications must be received by the County Election Board in the county where you are registered to vote by 5 p.m. on the third Monday (15 days) before an election.

Absentee Ballot Applications are valid for up to one calendar year.

Section 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Print your name as you are registered to vote. • Print your date of birth (MM/DD/YYYY). • State law requires voters to provide an identification number that matches the identification number provided on their voter registration record. You must supply an Oklahoma driver's license number/ State ID number or the last four digits of your Social Security number. (26 O.S. 14-105) If you do not know which number you used for your voter registration, please provide both.
Section 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide the physical address used for your residence address on your voter registration. Do not provide a rural route or P.O. Box number. • State law requires certain voters to confirm their address before submitting a request for absentee ballots. If you are an inactive voter, OR have been identified by the National Change of Address as having moved, OR have an invalid address for mailing by the United States Postal Service (USPS), OR have had a Voter ID card returned as undeliverable, you will need to complete an Address Confirmation Form and submit it with your absentee ballot request.
Section 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You must provide a valid email for the electronic delivery of your ballots. If you want your ballot return packet mailed to an address other than your voter registration address, check the appropriate box and provide the mailing address where you want your ballots to be mailed.
Section 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you are physically unable to vote in person at your precinct on the day of the election and you are blind as defined by 7 O.S. § 72, having a visual acuity not to exceed 20/200 in the better eye, with correcting lenses, or visual acuity greater than 20/200 but with limitation in the field of vision such that the widest diameter of visual field subtends an angle no greater than twenty degrees (20°), you may complete an Absentee Ballot Application requesting that an accessible absentee ballot be delivered to you electronically. • Upon approval of your application, an accessible absentee ballot will be delivered to you by email and an accessible absentee voting packet, containing an accessible absentee ballot affidavit envelope, will be delivered to you by United States mail. • Absentee ballots may be marked electronically, but must be printed and returned by mail, along with the absentee ballot affidavit, in the same manner as provided for affidavits in 26 O.S. § 14-113.2. • If you are physically incapacitated, you may choose an agent to deliver your application, the agent must print their name and sign the application in the box provided.
Section 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you want absentee ballots mailed to you for all elections in which you are eligible for this calendar year, check the first box. • If you want absentee ballots for a specific election, check the second box and print the date(s) of the election(s) in which you wish to vote by absentee ballot.
Section 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you are an Independent voter, you may check the box to request an absentee ballot for the Democratic Primary and/or Runoff Primary. NOTE: Only the Democratic Party currently allows Independents to vote in its Primary and Runoff Primary elections.
Section 7	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read the oath, then sign and date the application before submitting.

You must submit your own absentee ballot application. You may submit it by mail, email, or fax to your County Election Board. A voter who is physically incapacitated may also choose an agent to hand deliver the application to the County Election Board.
