



OK Election Data Warehouse Request to Access Voter Registration List

The Secretary of the State Election Board shall ensure that an electronic copy of the statewide voter registration list is made available, at no cost, to those individuals and organizations that meet the requirements of [26 O.S. § 7-103.2](#). To apply for **full access**, you must be:

- A bona fide resident of the State of Oklahoma and a citizen of the United States,
- A candidate for office in the state of Oklahoma, OR
- An official representative of a political party recognized by the state of Oklahoma.

About the OK Election Data Warehouse (EDW)

The OK Election Data Warehouse (EDW) is a public access site for raw data aggregation and **should not** be confused with the voter registration system, the results of an election, ballots cast or any device used in the conduct of elections in Oklahoma.

- Standard downloads and custom downloads in the EDW reflect data for **currently** registered voters only. However, a Deleted Voter List, for the past 24 months, is also available in the EDW.
- Neither the State Election Board nor the county election boards use EDW data for the certification of vote totals or in determining the winner of a particular election.
- Data in the EDW is updated each night and is current as of the date and time it is downloaded and/or printed.
- There is no charge to access the EDW, but you must submit a Request to Download Files Form.
- Access is valid for one year, but may be renewed.
- Access to the EDW is a complimentary service; therefore, the State Election Board **does not offer technical assistance** and is not responsible for data once it has been extracted.

Instructions for Requesting Access

To request access to the EDW, you must fill out the Request for Voter Registration List Form and check the appropriate box(es) on the form to confirm that you meet the requirements of [26 O.S. § 7-103.2](#). You may submit the completed form by email to info@elections.ok.gov.
