2026: Local Political Party Committee Reporting

County, Congressional District & Other Non-State Level Political Party Committees

Local Party Committees are only required to file a Statement of Organization and file reports when the committee makes:

- (1) a contribution of any amount to a State Candidate Committee;
- (2) an Independent Expenditure (IE); or
- (3) an Electioneering Communication (EC).

An additional report may be required for (2) or (3). See the IE and EC Calendar at the bottom of the page.

Due Dates: Look at the “Calendar Quarter” column and select the quarter that includes the date of the expenditure requiring the report. To determine what dates are included on the report see the information below the calendar.

1st Report of Calendar Year. The report will cover all committee activity from January 1st through the last day of the calendar quarter.

2nd and Subsequent Reports During a Calendar Year. The period covered in this report will begin with the day that follows the last date covered by the immediately preceding report (April 1, July 1, or October 1) and will end on the last day of the quarter.

Example 1: Committee X makes a contribution to candidate John Doe on May 4, 2026. Committee X has a report due between July 1 and July 31, 2026. The report will cover all contributions and expenditures made from January 1, 2026 through June 30, 2026. No further reports are required this calendar year if no other triggering expenses are made.

Example 2: Continuing with the example above, Committee X makes a contribution to candidate Mary Doe on October 15, 2026. Committee X has a report due between January 1 and January 31, 2027. The period covered in this report will be July - December 31, 2026.

INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURES & ELECTIONEERING COMMUNICATIONS REPORTS

Once the \$5,000 threshold is met, all expenditures for IEs or ECs must be reported regardless of amount.

Between June 2 – June 16, 2026	Next Business Day reporting required when making IE/ECs of \$5,000 or more in the aggregate during this period

On or Prior to August 10, 2026 and not previously reported	August 11 – August 17, 2026
Between August 11 – August 25, 2026	Next Business Day reporting required when making IE/ECs of \$5,000 or more in the aggregate during this period
AUGUST 25, 2026 PRE-RUNOFF ELECTION	
On or Prior to October 19, 2026 and not previously reported	October 20 – October 26, 2026
Between October 20 – November 3, 2026	Next Business Day reporting required when making IE/ECs of \$5,000 or more in the aggregate during this period
NOVEMBER 3, 2026 - GENERAL ELECTION
