Review by the Oklahoma State Fire Marshal's Office shall not relieve the applicant of the responsibility of compliance with all applicable codes and standards. When the owner has not engaged an architect or registered engineer, and the same is not required by law or by the Oklahoma Architectural and or Oklahoma Engineering Act(s) and or rules, the owner must submit this certificate of completion when appropriate, but always under his signature.
