EXECUTIVE ORDER 2019-36**

On the 18<sup>th</sup> anniversary of September 11, we continue to remember those who perished and we honor the heroic sacrifices and deeds of service from our nation's firefighters, law enforcement, military service members, rescue teams, and other Americans, who showed great courage and love of country that fateful September morning.

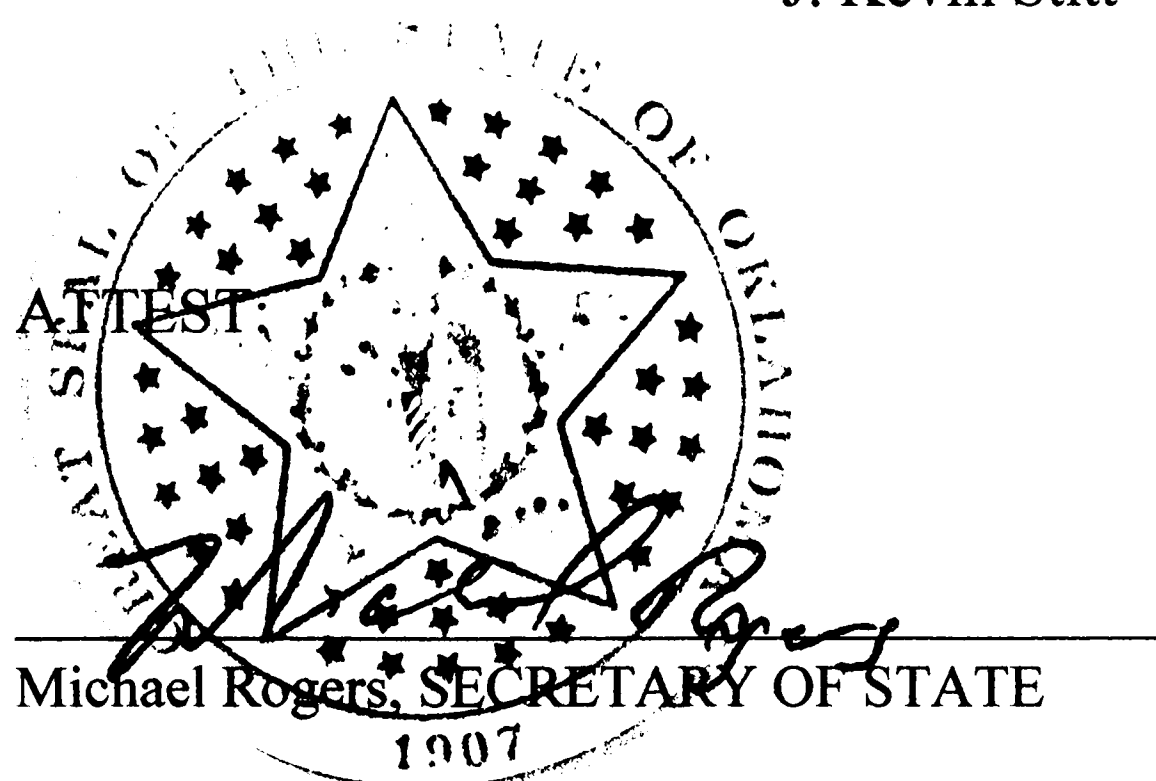
This executive order shall be forwarded to the Division of Capital Assets Management, who shall cause the provisions of this order to be implemented by all appropriate agencies of state government.
