

# Sports Betting Done Right in Oklahoma

## Retail Event Wagering

- Conducted by federally recognized Indian tribes pursuant to a State-Tribal Compact
- Revenue taxed at 15%
- Only in-person bets accepted

## Mobile Event Wagering

- Conducted pursuant to a license issued by the State of Oklahoma (initial licensing fee of \$500,000; annual licensing fee of \$100,000)
- Revenue taxed at 20%

## Prohibited Wagers

- Bettors will be unable to place bets on the individual performance of student-athletes, coaches, and referees
- Bettors will be unable to place bets on player injuries
- Bettors will be unable to make prop bets on collegiate competition
- Subject to change based on NCAA and athletic conference standards and regulations

## Rules and Regulations

- Mobile and brick-and-mortar, in-person betting will be held to the same rules and regulations
- Rules and regulations will focus on transparency, accountability, and consumer protection
