Our Behavioral Health Clinician provides a full range of behavioral health services including:

- Autism Screening.
- Counseling services for children and their families struggling with emotional and behavioral problems.
- Coping skills to reduce impact of adversity or challenges.
- Parent-Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT) - Strengthening bonds and decreasing discipline issues for ages 2-6.
- Consultation to parents, childcare providers, teachers and other professionals on mental health related topics such as:
 - Social-emotional competence.
 - Children and divorce.
 - Managing anger.
 - Grief and loss.
 - Behavior concerns.
 - Stress management.

Developmental Screenings & Assessments

Developmental screening can tell a caregiver if their child is on track with their development or if they may need additional services to enhance their developmental skills.
