Update on grant applications: Joyce updated the group regarding two grants MCH is awaiting a decision on. The first grant is the Maternal Health Innovation grant. She explained that this grant is currently ending it's five year cycle but have been approved for the next cycle of funding, however, this cycle will have half of the funding of the previous. Enhancing Reviews and Surveillance to Eliminate (ERASE) Maternal Mortality. This grant focuses on Maternal Mortality Review Committees throughout the nation. She commented that the possibility of receiving this grant is promising but final announcement has yet to be made.

Nikki further continued by stating that if the ERASE grant is received, two additional positions would become available. The hope is to hire an additional abstractor and a social worker to perform the informant interviews.

Additional cases for review: Nikki informed the group that there were additional cases from calendar year 2022 linked for review.

Discussion regarding Government relations: Dr. Smith began by stating that the latest legislative session ended much like the previous session where they thought items were progressing but then failed. He continues to stay in contact with both the House and Senate to try to promote the items being requested. He stated that these items will be requested once again in the next legislative session.

Dr. Hawkins next stated that overall, the latest session did have some positive effects regarding the MMRC. She informed the group that a lot of bills were killed that would have had negative effects on women's healthcare, the got expedited partner therapy legalized in Oklahoma, and some pros and cons regarding the MMRC bill. She also stated that the biggest win came when they realized legislators were reaching out and asking questions regarding various bills being proposed.

Discussion and approval or denial of the Morbidity and Mortality Annual Report: Jenna presented a brief presentation to the group outlining some of the topics included in the Morbidity and Mortality Annual Report. She began by showing the new items included in the report. She stated that an Executive Summary has been added which details an overview of the main points listed in the report. She mentioned that additional data has been added that breaks down maternal morbidity by age and compares with rates throughout the U.S. There is also a brief history or the MMRC, newly passed legislation, and timing and preventability by cause of death. A key successes section has also been included as well as a list of recommendations that were given during the reviews and steps that are being taken to follow up on those. Lastly, she stated a tribal addendum has been adding showing data from the tribes and incorporating it in with MMRC reviews.

Dr. Smith asked for a motion to approve or reject the Morbidity and Mortality Annual Report with Dr. Stanley making a motion to approve and Kayla Robison seconding. Members voted accordingly.

She stated that based on the recommendation regarding working with hospitals on treatment of pregnant women they have four different courses for emergency personnel regarding obstetrics and obstetric emergencies doing simulations. There were approximately 80 participants and there are plans for these simulations to continue next year.

She also stated that social media posts are being shared regarding vital signs and the importance of obtaining them prior to hospital discharge. And stressing the importance of investigating the cause of abnormal readings.

Jill also wanted to share some information regarding 211 and stated she would bring some printed information to the next meeting showing some of the services they provide.

Moment of silence: Dr. Smith asked the members to observe a moment of silence in remembrance of the women who lost their lives and the families they left behind.
