Welcome and Introductions: Presented by Tia Yancey

- Welcomed the OCCN members and called the meeting to order.
- Informed OCCN members that Smartsheet will be available in the near future to use as a communication tool to track projects and update progress in the work groups
- Introduced the idea of utilizing dashboards to track progress on the State Plan. Ms. Yancey presented dashboards from Colorado, New York and Pennsylvania for the OCCN members to consider. The OCCN members chose to utilize Tableau, which is used by Colorado.
- Informed OCCN members that the meeting in June 2019 will be cancelled due to a scheduling conflict.

Review of Cancer State Plan: Presented by Tia Yancey

- Informed OCCN members that since the Oklahoma State Cancer Plan was released on May 10, 2018 it is time to begin a review.
- The following areas of the Oklahoma State Cancer Plan were reviewed:
 - HPV, Breast Cancer, Cervical Cancer, Colorectal Cancer
- As a result of the review the following action items were indicated:
 - Outreach to interested organizations will be made to assist with meeting the goals of Obesity (Physical Activity and Nutrition)
 - Contact Tobacco/Lung Cancer workgroups to get an update on the efforts of the ABLE Commission contract
 - OHCA will review the Breast Cancer section regarding Connect4
 - OCCN members indicated the need for updating the cervical cancer section to include increasing the number of females to receive screening
 - OCCN members indicated the colorectal cancer goal should be updated to match the current goal of 80% screening in every community.
 - The initial review was not completed at this meeting. The review will continue at the next meeting.
