COVID 19 Effects on HPV Vaccinations:

- Nationwide decrease of HPV vaccinations by 73%; greater than TDAP I Meningitis
- AAP & CDC resources on continuation of vaccinations

COVID 19 Effects on HPV Vaccination:

- Immunization rates are down because of COVID-19
- 2 year olds and younger for well child & immunizations to prevent outbreak that is vaccine preventable

Legislation Update: Medicaid Expansion, TSET and Tobacco 21

Medicaid Expansion:

- Medicaid cover Us Project
- Half a million Oklahomans would be granted access to healthcare
- Two proposals: Referendum at the end of June & Governor Stitt's proposal
- Submitted state plan amendment for July 1st for Sooner Care to expand to adults
- OHCA waiting for funding
 - (Step 1): Submitted for waiver for adults to get access to Sooner Care choice; community medical home
 - Step 2): Voting for state question on Medicaid Expansion (SQ 802) occurs on June 30th, 2020

TSET:

- Legislature looking to take 75% of future payments for Medicaid Expansion
- Would have to be voted on by Oklahoma citizens since it is a constitutionally created trust
- TSET is the least desirable place to find state dollars for Medicaid match dollars because it provides critical primary prevention efforts
- \$12 per capita on prevention vs \$844 per capital on treatment for tobacco & obesity caused diseases

Tobacco 21:

- Bill to raise the minimum purchase age of tobacco to 21 passed the House & Senate-It is waiting on Governor Stitt's signature
- Industry-backed language won; language proposed by public health experts did not happen
