

## REQUESTED EXCEPTIONS TO OSDH TERMS

Instructions:

1. Any requested exception or revision to terms or conditions provided by OSDH shall be inserted in this template. Each requested exception or revision shall identify: (i) the document and section reference of the specific affected term; and (ii) either that the term is inapplicable and should be intentionally omitted or offer alternative language if the applicant is requesting revision of the term. An example is provided on the table below for illustrative purposes only.
2. Use tracked changes to propose alternative language, added language, or other revision. Requests not shown as tracked changes may be returned to the applicant for compliance with this requirement and review will be delayed as a result.
