### INITIAL RULE IMPACT STATEMENT

# TITLE 310. OKLAHOMA STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CHAPTER 605. ADULT DAY CARE CENTERS

### 1. **DESCRIPTION:**

O.S. 63 § 1-872 was updated in 2024 to exempt (PACE) organizations from Adult Day Care Center (ADC) licensure. The proposed rule language aligns Chapter 605 with this statutory change.

## 2. DESCRIPTION OF PERSONS AFFECTED AND COST IMPACT RESPONSE:

PACE program operators will not be required to have an Adult Day Care license if only caring for PACE recipients. Adult Day Care licensure fees for exempted entities will no longer be required.

# 3. <u>DESCRIPTION OF PERSONS BENEFITING, VALUE OF BENEFIT AND EXPECTED HEALTH OUTCOMES:</u>

The benefit of the proposed language is clarity related to regulatory requirements due to the uniformity of rule and statute.

There are no fee changes associated with the proposed rule change. There are no anticipated economic impacts or costs for compliance.
