## OSDH Endemic State

(as of May 11, 2023)

### Data & Reporting

- Weekly reporting at individual case level
- Weekly reporting to CDC includes individual cases
- OK2SHARE: updated weekly

- Weekly and monthly respiratory surveillance reporting at community level (in alignment with flu season)
- Finalized year-end data reported to CDC
- OK2SHARE: only finalized year-end data published

### Testing

- County Health Departments (CHDs) provide testing assistance to high-risk settings during outbreaks; may provide testing\*
- Variant sequencing conducted

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### Vaccine

- CHDs may provide vaccine\*
- Personal vaccine records available online\*\*

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### Treatments

- Monoclonal and antiviral tracking and distribution

- Treatment may be available through individual health care providers

### Investigation

- Individual case investigation and contact tracing automated
- OSDH supports high-risk setting outbreak investigation
