



Funding Source Tip Sheet

Funding Source Description	HL7 CODE	When to use
VFC	VXC1	When vaccination is funded by the Vaccines for Children Program (VFC). See below document for details.
STATE	VXC2	Only County Health Departments take part in this program and are the only facilities who utilize this funding source.
PRIVATE	PHC70	Use when vaccine is purchased with facilities' private funds.
PAN	VXC50	Only used for COVID-19 Vaccination Administrations.
317	317	If your facility is a part of this program this funding will be used. For more details, please contact Vaccinehelp@health.ok.gov

Definitions

VFC: Funding used for the Vaccines for Children Program, a federally funded entitlement program that provides vaccines at no cost to children who are younger than 19 years of age and is one of the following: Medicaid eligible, uninsured, underinsured, American-Indian or Alaskan Native).

State: Funding for clients (adults and children) with private insurance, adults with Medicaid, clients that claim to have insurance but do not have proof (clients will be charged on a sliding scale). Additionally used for clients with Medicare Part B only, Medicare Part D (only influenza). See below document on page 2 for further details. This vaccine funding source is **ONLY** available for County Health Departments.

Private: Vaccines that have been purchased using a facilities' private funds.

Pan: Funding for **ONLY** COVID-19 Vaccine

317: Section-317 funded vaccines. Section 317 of the Public Health Service Act authorizes the federal purchase of vaccines to vaccinate adults with no insurance, adults whose private insurance does not cover the requested vaccine (underinsured adults), and when approved by central office (OSDH) for outbreaks and emergencies.
