From 2020 to 2024, **Tillman County** had the **21st highest** drug overdose death rate in the state.

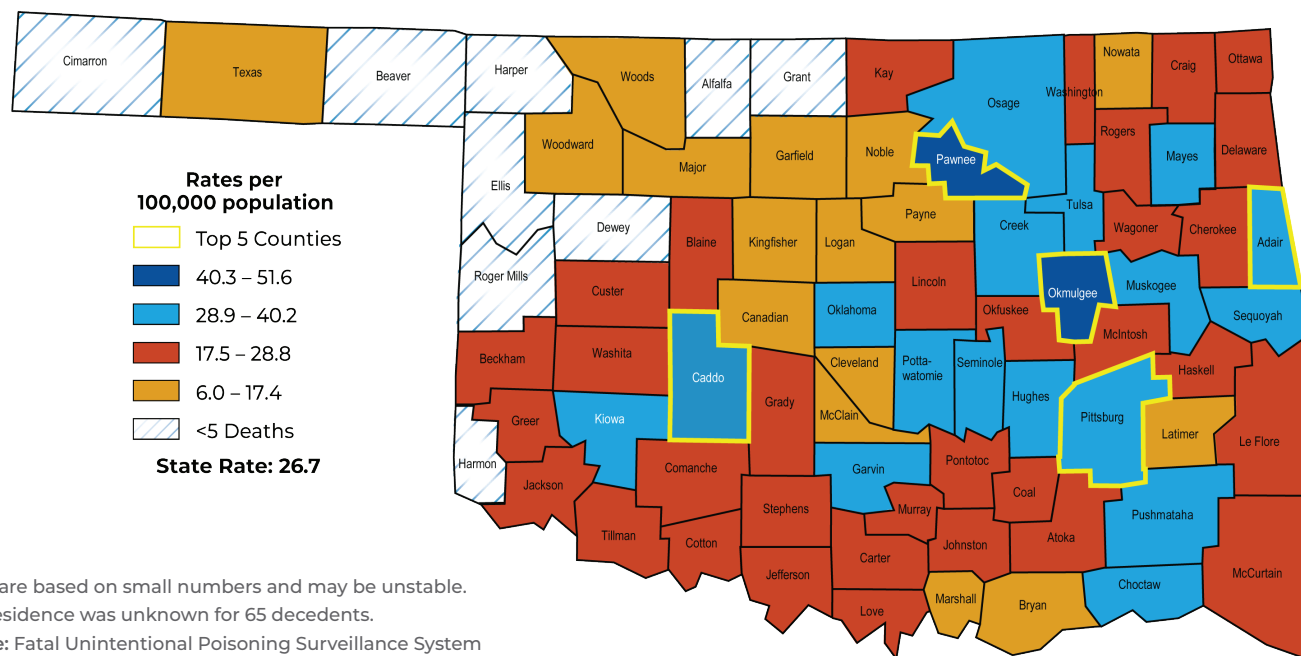
80% of deaths occurred at a home or apartment.

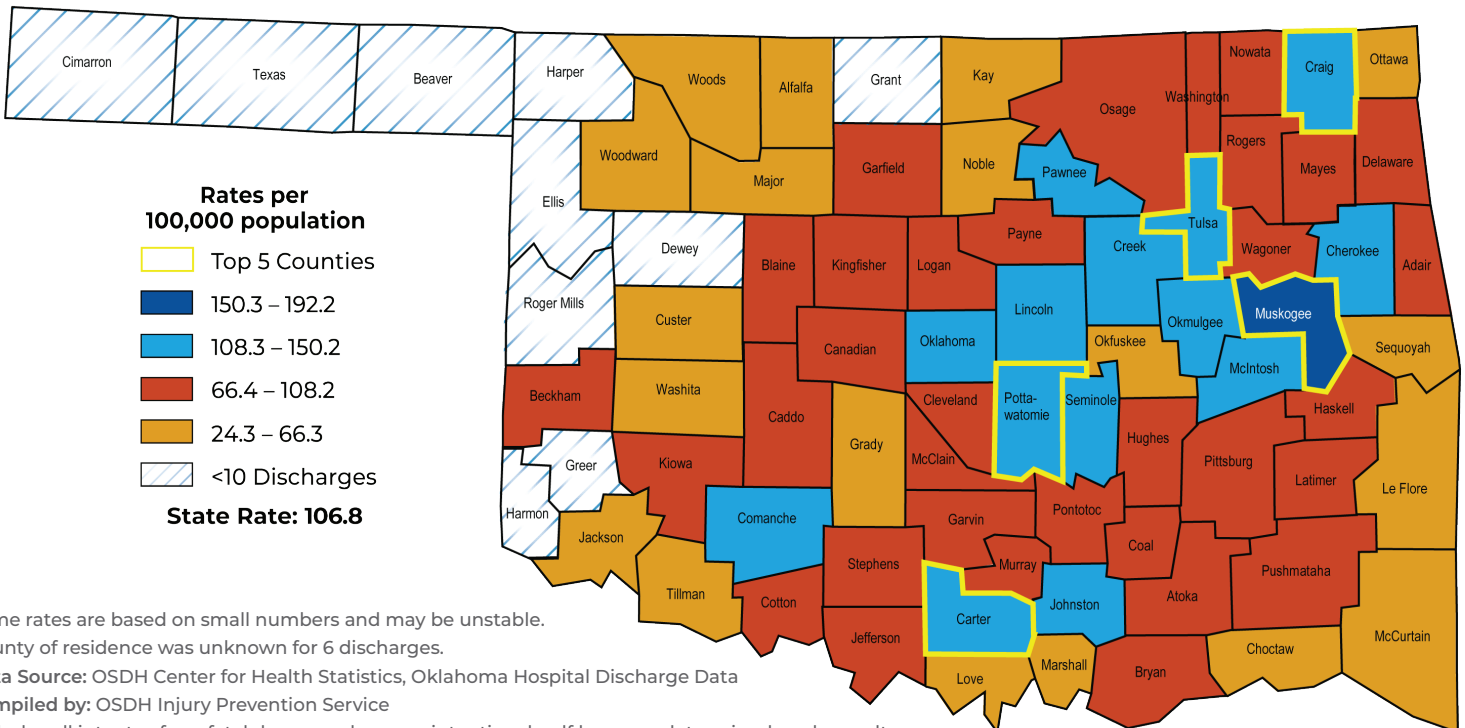

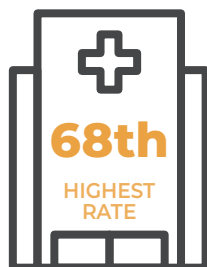

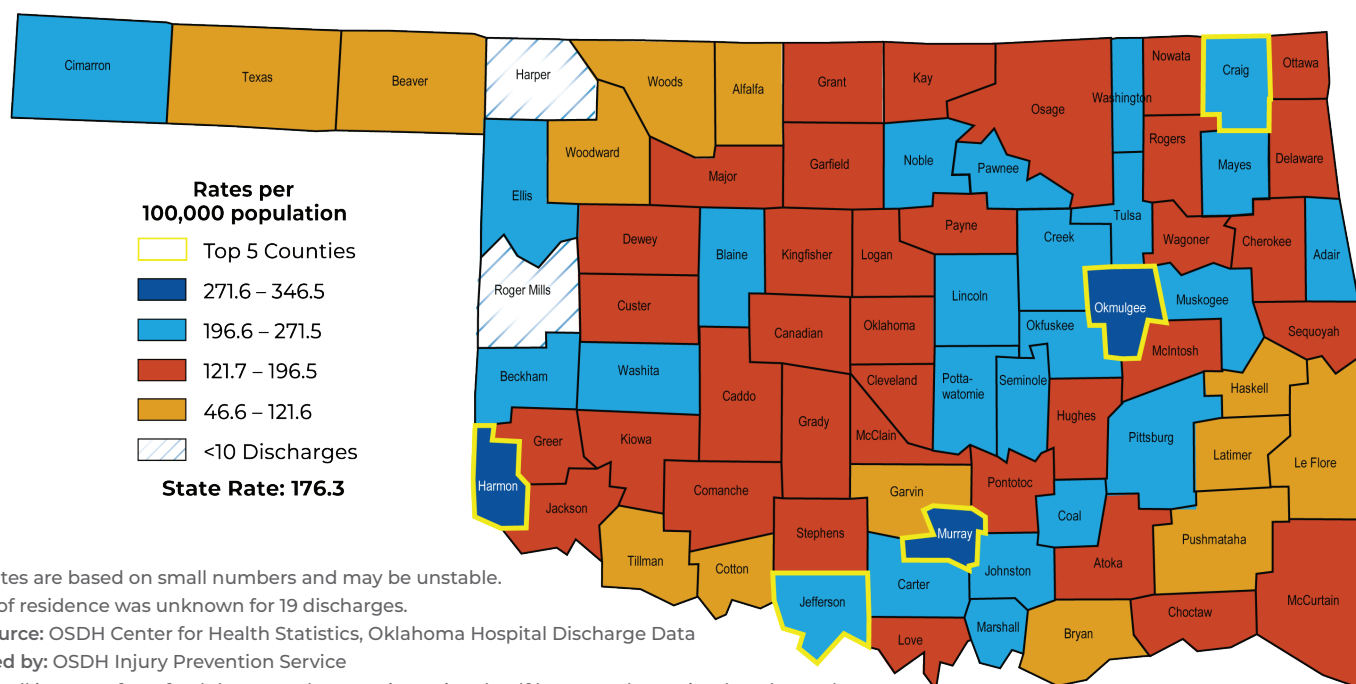
■ Non-Hispanic White Tillman County residents had the **highest** rate of drug overdose ED discharges.
