- Commonly manifests anytime between birth and the first three months of life

1. Snuffles – full of spirochetes
 2. Rash
 3. Hepatosplenomegaly
- Osteochondritis
 - Anemia
 - Jaundice
 - Neurologic signs
 - Lymphadenopathy
 - Mucous patches
 - Placental abnormalities
