

CMP IN-PERSON VISITATION COVID-19 APPLICATIONS & PAYMENT CHECKLIST

1. CMS GUIDANCE

- TO APPLY FOR COVID-19 IN-PERSON VISITATION AIR QUALITY DEVICES**
Become familiar with **CMS QSO-20-39-NH-Revised** for the purchase of technology. The Oklahoma spending limit is **\$2,500** per CMS certified Medicare, Medicaid, and dually participating facilities.
- TO APPLY FOR COVID-19 IN-PERSON VISITATION AIDS (TENTS, PLEXIGLASS, ETC.)**
Become familiar with **CMS QSO 20-39-NH-Revised**. The Oklahoma spending limit is **\$1,500** per CMS certified Medicare, Medicaid, or dually participating facilities **who did not previously receive this CMP funding for In-Person Visitation Aids**.

2. APPLICATIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS

- Go to the Oklahoma CMP website located at CMP.health.ok.gov, under the “*Apply for Funding*” tab on the left side of the screen and obtain the following documents:
 - ❖ In-Person Visitation Aids Applications
 - ❖ Vendor Payee Form, if not previously provided
 - ❖ In-Person Visitation Aids Checklist
 - ❖ In-Person Visitation Aids FAQs
- The application requires a quote or cost estimate for the items requested.
- E-mail the application and vendor payee form (if applicable) to CMP@health.ok.gov.

3. WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

- If additional information is needed, we will e-mail the contact person shown on the application
- Expect an approval letter within 10 workdays
- Then, the facility may purchase approved items, and
- Upon receipt of the approved items, request a reimbursement following the instructions below

4. FOR REIMBURSEMENT, WE NEED:

- The **Vendor/Payee Form** – This form is not required if previously provided to the OSDH CMP department.
- A copy of the final receipt(s) (Receipts should indicate a zero balance and proof items were purchased and received.)



- The amount expected as a reimbursement. (The receipts are not always self-explanatory.)

- Which part of the Social Security Act is the facility certified to participate? Title 18 (Medicare), Title 19 (Medicaid), Dually participating
