3. Review and Discuss Meeting Minutes from May 10, 2024

4. HADF Practical Exam

Discussion regarding concerns about possible changes to the HADF practical exam. A practical exam work group met and made suggestions and there was documentation regarding recommendations for changes to the exam. Concerns were raised about not having subject matter experts taking part in the exam changes. A main concern regarding the practical exam is the masking section and the percentage of the overall test score it holds. The council was advised that OSDH is currently reviewing all the tests for updates and changes to be made. Any changes to the test would be brought before the council for review and input prior to being implemented. Discussion about the possibility of having another work group to go over the practical exam and OSDH will investigate this and attempt to find a way to get subject matter experts involved in reviewing the practical exam.

5: Medical Micropigmentation Practical Exam

Discussion regarding the medical micropigmentation exam coincided with the discussion regarding the HADF practical examination. The same concerns were raised about previous groups having met, with no changes being implemented. Also, ensuring that subject matter experts were involved in the review process for the exam. OSDH is currently reviewing this exam and would bring the exam to the board prior to it being utilized. We are also looking into ways to get industry leaders involved in the review if possible within the scopes of the Oklahoma Statutes and Administrative Code.
