Legislation Discussion: 2024 Governor-Signed Legislation

James Leewright-HB 2975- Allows homemade food processors to obtain registration numbers from the Department of Agriculture. Effective November 1, 2024. HB 2995- Courier bill. Signed and is effective November 1, 2024. Mobile food trucks fire suppression systems. Allows until 2025 for food trucks to become compliant.

Agenda Item 8:

Discussion: Recommendations for Addressing Top Violations

Discussion regarding the use of the numbers reported and how they are used by the different health departments. The numbers are used for training and as a tool to help utilize and focus resources in the field. Discussion regarding how the council can help to address risk factors. A suggestion was made to take the information to the Oklahoma Restaurant Association and discuss possible ways to help work on corrective action. The ORA Show is being held in August 2024 and this will be a good venue for helping with passing on information and helping in this area.
