The second thing I'd like to just point out to the committee is that the whole emergency system stabilization and improvement involving revolving funds is almost a one fiscal year delay. He also wants the council to be made aware of the shortage of blood. He has been trying to get blood out in the rural areas but has run into roadblocks.
