DRAFT MINUTES

1. Judy Dyke called the meeting to order at 10:47 a.m.
2. Roll Call was taken by Judy Dyke, Chair. Attendance was recorded and quorum was met.
3. Ed Martin made a motion to approve February 10, 2026 minutes and seconded by Michelle Wolfe. The motion passes unanimously.
4. Emergency System Report- David Graham, Trauma Coordinator, OSDH gave an update on OERSSIRF scoring panel. They were just scored and the awardees should receive their money by July 1st. A little over \$2.7 million was awarded and about \$140,000 will carry over for next year. Out of the 34 applicants 27 were funded. Judy asked if there was anything specific to the region and David is unsure at this time. There are microgrants being set up right now for rural EMS that agencies can apply for. With ACS there is a meeting June 4th for the ETSE working groups at Pafford Corporate Office. There is also virtual meetings happening next month. We are in the middle of working on a rule rewrite to be compliant with EMS compact that allows for fingerprinting and FBI background checks. There isn't anything within our current statute or rule that allows for that. So that is something we are working on.
5. **Business**
 - Discussion, consideration, possible action and vote to revise the Region 2 Stroke Guidelines.
Judy started with the last copy that was edited in August of 2024. The person who did the most recent changes has not responded to calls, emails or text. Judy did not receive an invitation to the April meeting where a lot of those changes were made. The newest version was not shared. Judy wanted her to attend today because the committee feels they should have that information. We can't make much progress if they don't have the current information on those guidelines. Judy expressed her frustration with the lack of communication. It is recommended at this time to table the draft until the August meeting. Ed Martin made a motion to table this topic until the August meeting and seconded by Elizebeth Wright. Motion passes unanimously.
6. New Business, Judy, wanted to state she is part of the statewide committee for RHTP and asked if anyone had suggestions for recommendations for changes or improvements that can be made that would be more helpful to the region. A virtual option is something the committee would like to see. Those that drive far and have conflicts this would be easier for them to do and attend the meeting. Judy then asked if Pulsara was being added to the communication platform across the state. David responded, that is rural health transformation and that is something they are looking into. There are multiple states that use it statewide and Arkansas uses it heavily along with Texas. Which they used it for the flood and hurricane disasters.
