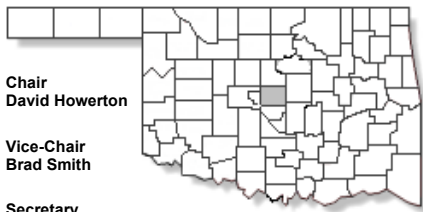

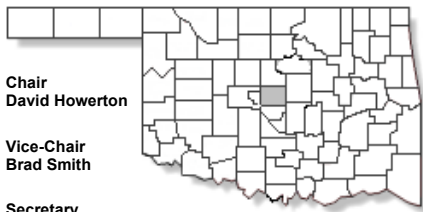

- Reports
 - Dean Henke reminded attendees that any OSDH inquiries be directed to Esystems@health.ok.gov .  - David Gooshaw reported the CQI Committee had 14 members in attendance today. They reviewed 9 case and drafted 11 letters. Mr. Gooshaw encouraged members to respond in a timely manner if they receive any letters so the committee can close the cases.
 - Brad Smith reported the RPC is editing the Region 8 Trauma Plan, however the RPC did not meet this morning.

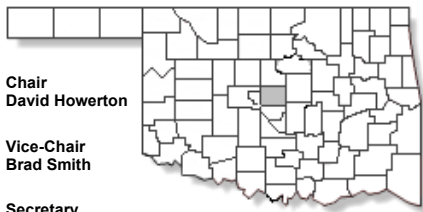

- Heather Yazdanipour with Regional Medical Response System (RMRS) reported they will be starting a new 5 years cooperative agreement and working on a 1-year and 5-year budget plus a 5-year work plan. RMRS will be focusing on Surge Management and Staffing. There are 3 exercises planned. Spring exercises will be Chemical Surge, Medical Readiness, and Mental Health Recovery. For further information, contact the RMRS.
 - Zachary Sinsheimer reported the Region 8 Prehospital Trauma Transports reports were prepared by Maxine Council and himself. There was a spike in October and November 2023 for both EMSA and SSM Saint Anthony Midwest EMS. On the graph, Green represents Priority III, Yellow is Priority II, and Red is Priority 1 trauma patients. Dr. Cross commented that OU Health’s Level III volume is up 180%. OUs stroke volume has increased due to auto accept where the patient was listed as “Found Down”. The slides are included in your meeting packets.

 7. Kathy Stillwell reported the Region 8 Stroke plan is a work in progress.
 8. Discussion, consideration, possible action and vote to include the following section in the Regional Trauma Plan.....Brad Smith, Vice Chair
 - Stand-alone ERs role and responsibilities in the trauma system including updating EMResource
David Smith shared two concerns with the Free-Standing Emergency Departments (FSED) - membership to the RTAB, and participation on EMResource. He further shared that at the least the FSED need to participate on EMResource to report bed delays, capacity issues and to improve communications. Integris has 2 FSER, SSM has 5 FSED, and OU has 2 FSED. Heather Yazdanipour said it would be helpful if the FSED were on EMResource so when operating in a real world event to identify their capabilities. David Smith asked if having the umbrella organization represent the FSEDs sufficient. Michelle Faulkner shared that all 5 FSERs report to the main campus and is working well. OU and Integris shared the same. Invites to the RTAB would come from the main campuses. Brad Smith asked if OSDH could provide the training for EMResource and Heather Yazdanipour said Anya Grether would have to set up the accounts for EMResource and then RMRS could help with the training.
 - Jason Likens made a motion to add the FSEDs to EMResource and to offer an invitation to become RTAB members and was seconded by Larry Terry. The motion carried as follows:
