# ALZHEIMER'S DEMENTIA OR OTHER FORMS OF DEMENTIA COMPLAINT PROCESS

If you believe that State or Federal regulations have been violated and you did not receive a copy of the Alzheimer's dementia disclosure form, you can file a complaint.

A complaint may be made by email or telephone. Here's how:

# **DISCLOSURE FORM**

Any special care unit, program, or facility where care is provided for persons with Alzheimer's dementia or other forms of dementia, stating that such persons or their representatives are to be given a copy of the disclosure form. If the disclosure form is not provided, a complaint may be filed with the Consumer Protection Unit of the Office of the Attorney General.

## **ONLINE:**

File a consumer complaint with the Office of Attorney General by clicking or scanning the QR code to download and complete the form.

Then save the completed form as a PDF and email it to **ConsumerProtection@oag.ok.gov** with "**Complaint**" in the subject line. Please attach any relevant documentation to your email.
