  - A. Emergency Systems Report: Dan Whipple
    1. Emergency Systems is fully staffed and introduced Mr. Samuel Curatola EMS Administrator, Ms. Darlene Alexander Administrative Assistant and Xana Howard Statistical Research Specialist.
    2. Report Writer is now functional for those agencies that use it for reports.

  - B. Regional Sub-Committee Report
    1. Continuous Quality Improvement Sub-Committee: Heather Booher CQI presented three cases and two follow up cases from last quarter from Region 3. Ms. Booher encourages audience participation. None of the cases followed the trauma plan for their respective region. The follow ups the committee accepted the response. Ms. Booher asked for CQI referrals and reminded them that they are not punitive.
    2. Regional Planning Committee: Richie Bohach stated the REPC meet this morning and discussed a few more idea's for the regional stroke plan. The committee will be meeting on March 2, 2017 at 10:00 AM to try and complete a draft plan to bring to the next RTAB on April 6, 2017.
    3. Regional Medical Planning Groups / SW Medical Response Center – Bob Stewart EM Resource survey hospitals was at 90% and EMS was 84%. The MERC conducted an MCI drill on January 17, 2017. Morning participation was 48% at 11:00 AM. Conducted a second MCI drill in the afternoon and participation was 71% at 3:00 PM. We have not had three consecutive months at or above 75% so we will continue to have monthly MCI drills. Bob advised all agencies to update their EMResource link because it has changed. The new site will take effect March 1, 2017. We have evacuation planning meeting on February 23, 2017 in Ardmore from 9:00 to 11:00. MCI planning meeting on March 7, 2017 from 1:30 to 3:30 in Chickasha. Southwest Emergency Managers meeting March 9 and 10 in Duncan focusing on recovery operations and how agencies can get public assistance. If you have any questions contact Bill Henrion. RMPG meeting today at 1:00 PM first net will give demonstration and hands on with their new network. We will also be looking at the MCI plan review. Lessons learned on the Duncan water crisis.
