

Critical Update Regarding State of Oklahoma (OKEMSIS) URL Change

****Action Required****

The State of Oklahoma will be transitioning the State of Oklahoma (OKEMSIS) incident repository site to a new hosting environment. As part of this transition you will be required to update the URL currently being used to access this site to complete any 3rd party export requests or direct incident entry referencing the URL/web address convention.

Deadline Date: **January 4th, 2019**

There are Internet URL changes that all services using the State of Oklahoma OKEMSIS site have to implement or verify before **January 4th, 2019**.

1. **All third party vendors and agencies connecting to OKEMSIS Elite will require a configuration update so that their records continue to upload properly after the transition date.**
 - a. The new configuration will provide internet routing to the new server location.
 - b. Please make this change now so you can test connectivity to the new URL now.
 - c. If you do not make this change now your data transmissions will fail once the migration is complete. You should be able to make the URL modifications and resend any failed data if this occurs.
2. Vendor/Agency submissions through the web-service will be interrupted for up to seven business days beginning January 7, 2019. You will not be able to access the website until the migration is complete.

The OKEMSIS system move will result in up to 7 days in downtime occurring January 7th through January 13th, 2019.
