- Introductions and sharing of program information
- Announcements
 - parentPRO Commercials have started in English and Spanish

Special Updates:

- **HV Safety Manual Revision**
 - Committee has met several times and also correspond via email
 - There have multiple new additions i.e. drugs and car safety
 - Cathy Sullivan made a pencil sketch and Office of Communication are working to bring the sketch to life.
 - Department of Mental Health and others have provided input information into the manual
 - The manual will only be electronic, paper copies will not be provided
 - Power Points have not been developed as of yet.

- **MIECHV Innovation Grant Proposal (as well as general updates):**
 - **On a MISSION to prove Home Visiting**
 - **Annette Wisk Jacobi, J.D., Director Family Support & Prevention Service**
 - There has been no word on the budget. No talk of renewing OCAP.
 - Legislature still trying to get revenue string.
 - If FSPS can be of service to any programs we would love to make arrangements.
 - We could still provide help with trainings and programs are able to attend.
 - There would be a fee to have access to the ETO system.
 - Technical Assistance can still be provided.
 - FSPS is trying to create a structure for all of us to work together.

- **RFP-MIECHV PAT**
 - RFPs have been received and scored.
 - Have been sent to OMES to be awarded.
 - New vendors applied for RFP and it was very competitive.
 - All applications were impressive.

- **Community Connector**
 - Oklahoma County
 - 2 applications
 - Being sent to OMES at the end of the week

- **Children First/Pilot**
 - Do not know if there will be any changes.
 - There have been no new updates.

- **MIECHV Grant Proposal: Innovation Grant**
 - Start to complete is 2 years.
 - Grant focuses on research, evaluation, and improving quality of service. i.e. CQI.
 - Will be partnering with OU Center of Child Abuse and Neglect as well as the University of Kansas
 - Brought in MIECHV funded sites like the Cherokee Nation MIECHV Tribe.
 - We will continue our efforts and focus on recruitment, but will move from recruitment and focus on engagement.
 - Lemonade for life may be a way to engage with clients.
 - University of Kansas has seen preliminary positive results.
 - Also what other HV have come up with; very competitive.

- **Data Collectors: Cortisol Test**
 - Will collect spit from moms to test stress levels
 - Test will allow us to see if stress levels reduce
 - Some may see it as invasive - only downfall
 - The test are not to 'catch clients', but more how can we help them feel better.
 - It is not to grade clients, but to grade our help.
 - Test depends on funding

- **Option1:** Other HV and clients to see if stress levels go down
 - **Option2:** Test mom and baby to see if their stress levels go up and down together.
 - Funding: 1 million for one year and 1 million for next year.
 - If we receive the maximum funding OU will determine which option we choose.
 - The grant is not services directed so funding will not go to the programs.
 - Grant was submitted May 17, 2016.
- **Lemonade for Life Training**
 - University of Kansas will do training.
 - The training will be in Oklahoma.
 - It is a theory-based training not checklist.
 - We will have a Hope Coach available 20 hrs. a week.
 - There is potential for Lemonade for Life Coaches: Train-the-Trainer
 - David Bard at OU will evaluate the training.
 - Materials will be translated into Spanish
 - There will be a cultural coach provided
 - Heavy criticism from programs on cultural coach is needed.
 - Could learn in September 2016 if we were awarded.
 - Will be for NEW clients.

Introduction of New Deputy Commissioner:

- **Tina R. Johnson, MPH, RN**
 - Familiar with the county level
 - Very good day-to-day working knowledge of Home Visiting
 - Started as a Public Health Nurse in Lincoln County then became a District Nurse Manager with the Nurse Family Partnership Oklahoma's Children First
 - Tina stated: "I am very appreciative and thankful for all the HV Programs."

Special Update:

- **CAP Month News & Events**
 - Blue Ribbon Tree slideshow will be uploaded to YouTube this year and will be a combination video and still shot slideshow with blue ribbon trees and participants describing GREAT CHILDHOODS which coincides with Prevent Child Abuse America and their hashtag #GreatChildhood and their theme.
 - Dr. Harvey Karp will be presenting at Metro Tech Springlake Drive Location followed by "Raising of America".
 - OSDH/FSPS will be creating a Map of Oklahoma and try to shade the state blue to see how many communities participate.
 - FSPS/CAP Action Committee and its partners will also be doing the Happiest Day Coloring Challenge again in its second year.

- Garfield County Advocacy Center made 340 wooden children and placed them on the courthouse lawn.
 - Was a huge community event
