

SFY 2017 FQHC Uncompensated Care Fund (UCF)

First Quarter Invoice Report

Of the 20 FQHCs in Oklahoma, 11 entered into a contract with the OSDH for assistance with uncompensated care costs incurred for providing primary care, dental, or behavioral health services to the uninsured. Of these 11 FQHCs, 8 submitted invoices, and of these 8, only 3 FQHCs were determined to be eligible for UCF assistance for services delivered July through September of 2016.

Note: * Number of patients/encounters only includes months in which the FQHC was eligible for reimbursement.





Quarterly UCF Reimbursement



In the First Quarter of State Fiscal Year 2017, the Uncompensated Care Fund reimbursed FQHCs for approximately **1,217** uninsured encounters.

Total UCC = \$226,414.52

Total UCF Available = \$578,646.48

The Uncompensated Care Fund reimbursed 100% of July and September claims. Only August claims exceeded the monthly UCF allotted amount.
