- Supplemental Food Program for Women, Infants, and Children
- Nutrition & Breastfeeding Education & Assistance
- Eligibility: Women who are pregnant, breastfeeding, or recently given birth, & infants & children to age 5, who meet eligibility guidelines.

Sooner Start

- Oklahoma's Early Intervention Program
- Designed for: families of infants and toddlers birth to 36 months who have developmental delays
- Regulated by the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, Part C & funded by Federal and State sources
- Services are offered at no charge to families and provided where child typically spends a majority of their time

Children First, OK Nurse Family Partnership

- No cost voluntary family support and home visitation program for 1st time moms who are expecting their first child (prior to 29 weeks to age 2) based on eligibility
- Prenatal Assessment
- Child safety & child development
- Education
- Services: child growth & development evaluations, nutrition education, parent/child relationships, life/goal setting
