## **Application Information**

The Oklahoma Office of Homeland Security in conjunction with the State of Oklahoma Cybersecurity Planning Committee are pleased to announce an open application period for the State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program. If you are interested in applying to this grant, first contact <a href="https://new.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov">https://new.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov</a> for a copy of the Oklahoma Statewide Cybersecurity Plan. This plan lays out four objectives for projects and explains what project types are allowable under each objective. Each application should be tied to one of objectives.

The objectives are:

Objective 1: Planning

Objective 2: Assessments

Objective 3: Monitoring

Objective 4: Training

Instructions for the application are on the top of the Investment Justification (IJ) worksheet. You can find the IJ worksheet at www.homelandsecurity.ok.gov under the grants tab.

Eligible applicants are state and local units of government, publicly funding educational institutions, and tribal governments. Non-profit and private institutions are not eligible for this grant.

Each application must be submitted to <a href="mailto:hsgrants@okohs.ok.gov">hsgrants@okohs.ok.gov</a> and then reviewed by the State of Oklahoma Cybersecurity Planning Committee. The committee meets once a quarter. You will be notified when your application will be reviewed and are encouraged to attend the meeting to answer any questions the committee may have.
