The Oklahoma Health Care Workforce Training Commission met for a meeting at 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 14, 2026, at the Oklahoma State Medical Association, 313 NE 50th Street., Oklahoma City, OK 73105. Chair, Mr. Khoury, called the meeting to order at 3:02 p.m. Roll call was established and the presence of a quorum with seven (7) Commission members present: Mr. Kevin Khoury, Ms. Kerri Bayer, Dr. Jonathan Bushman, Dr. Ryan Oden, Dr. Layne Subera, Dr. Paul Wright, and Mr. Douglas Williams.

Mr. Khoury asked those around the room to introduce themselves.

Dr. Bushman made a motion, seconded by Dr. Oden, to approve the minutes of the April 16, 2026, Commission meeting as presented. Those voting for the motion: Dr. Bushman, Dr. Oden, Mr. Khoury, Ms. Bayer, Dr. Subera, Mr. Williams and Dr. Wright. Those voting against the motion: None.

Ms. Fullingim gave the director's report. Ms. Fullingim attended the OSU – Life After Residency with Ms. Golding. Ms. Fullingim attended the Oklahoma Osteopathic Association – Spring Convention with Ms. Cecil. Ms. Fullingim stated that Ms. Golding and Ms. Mayo attended the Oklahoma Academy of Family Physicians Conference. Ms. Fullingim updates on Rural Health Transformation Project stating that House Bill 3066 has passed and HWTC will be signing a contract and starting the program soon. Ms. Fullingim discussed HWTC staff changes. Ms. Fullingim updates on new database software search.

Ms. Golding presented one (1) potential applicant for the Physician Loan Repayment Program. The applicant, Whitnie Holten-Nickel, D.O., is eligible to receive \$200,000.00. Mr. Williams made the motion to approve, Dr. Wright seconded. Those voting for the motion: Mr. Williams, Dr. Wright, Mr. Khoury, Ms. Bayer, Dr. Bushman, Dr. Oden, and Dr. Subera. Those voting against the motion: None.

Ms. Librandi presented a reimbursement request under \$50,000 approved by the Executive Director Pursuant to OAC 540:55-3-6(c)(1). Career Tech had one (1) reimbursement of \$29,102.66.

Ms. Librandi presented a reimbursement request ARPA Grant Reimbursement of \$50,000 or More to be Approved by the Commission Pursuant to OAC 540:55-3-6(c)(2)(B). Care Providers had one (1) reimbursement of \$56,331.28. Oklahoma City Community College had two (2) reimbursements of \$258,926.88 and \$426,665.62. Tulsa Community College had one (1) reimbursement of \$60,136.15. Dr. Bushman made a motion seconded by Mr. Williams, to approve the reimbursements. Those voting for the motion: Dr. Bushman, Mr. Williams, Mr. Khoury, Ms. Bayer, Dr. Oden, Dr. Subera, and Dr. Wright. Those voting against the motion: None.

Ms. Librandi presented a transfer and reallocation of approximately \$810,000 of unused administrative funds appropriated to redistribution of HWTC ARPA Administrative funds to projects that were underfunded per HB 4047 to eight (8) schools in equal amounts, pursuant to H.B. 4074, 60th Leg. 2d (Okla. 2026). Dr. Oden made the motion to approve, Dr. Wright seconded. Those voting for the motion: Dr. Oden, Dr. Wright, Mr. Khoury, Ms. Bayer, Dr. Bushman, Dr. Subera and Mr. Williams. Those voting against the motion: None.

Ms. Librandi presented notifying Langston University of potential transfer and reallocation of unused Health Care Workforce Revolving Funds in Mid-June if University continues to fail to submit reimbursements, Pursuant to H.B. 4074. Dr. Bushman made the motion to approve, Ms. Bayer seconded. Those voting for the motion: Dr. Bushman, Ms. Bayer, Mr. Khoury, Dr. Oden, Dr. Subera, Mr. Williams and Dr. Wright. Those voting against the motion: None.

There was no sign up for public comment.

At 3:49 p.m. Mr. Khoury adjourned the Commission Meeting.
