



RESOLUTION 24.052

Reconstituting the Public, Coastal, and Tribal Lands Committee as a Council of the Interstate Oil and Gas Compact Commission

WHEREAS, the Public, Coastal, and Tribal Lands Committee has operated as a standing committee under Article V, Section 6 of the Bylaws of the Interstate Oil and Gas Compact Commission (IOGCC), and

WHEREAS, the Public, Coastal, and Tribal Lands Committee provides a forum for the exchange of information, experience, and ideas and fosters collaboration on key issues pertaining to public, coastal, and tribal lands; and

WHEREAS, the Public, Coastal, and Tribal Lands Committee members have convened at each Annual Business Meeting and Annual Conference to provide value to each other, as well as the Member States, Associate Member States, and Affiliates, and

WHEREAS, the council structure, which combines roundtable discussions with timely presentations, will enhance communication and collaboration among the Member and Associate Member States and Affiliates of the IOGCC, and

WHEREAS, establishment of a council with standing equivalent to the Council of Regulatory Officials and the Council of Oil and Gas Attorneys will require an amendment of the IOGCC Bylaws.


