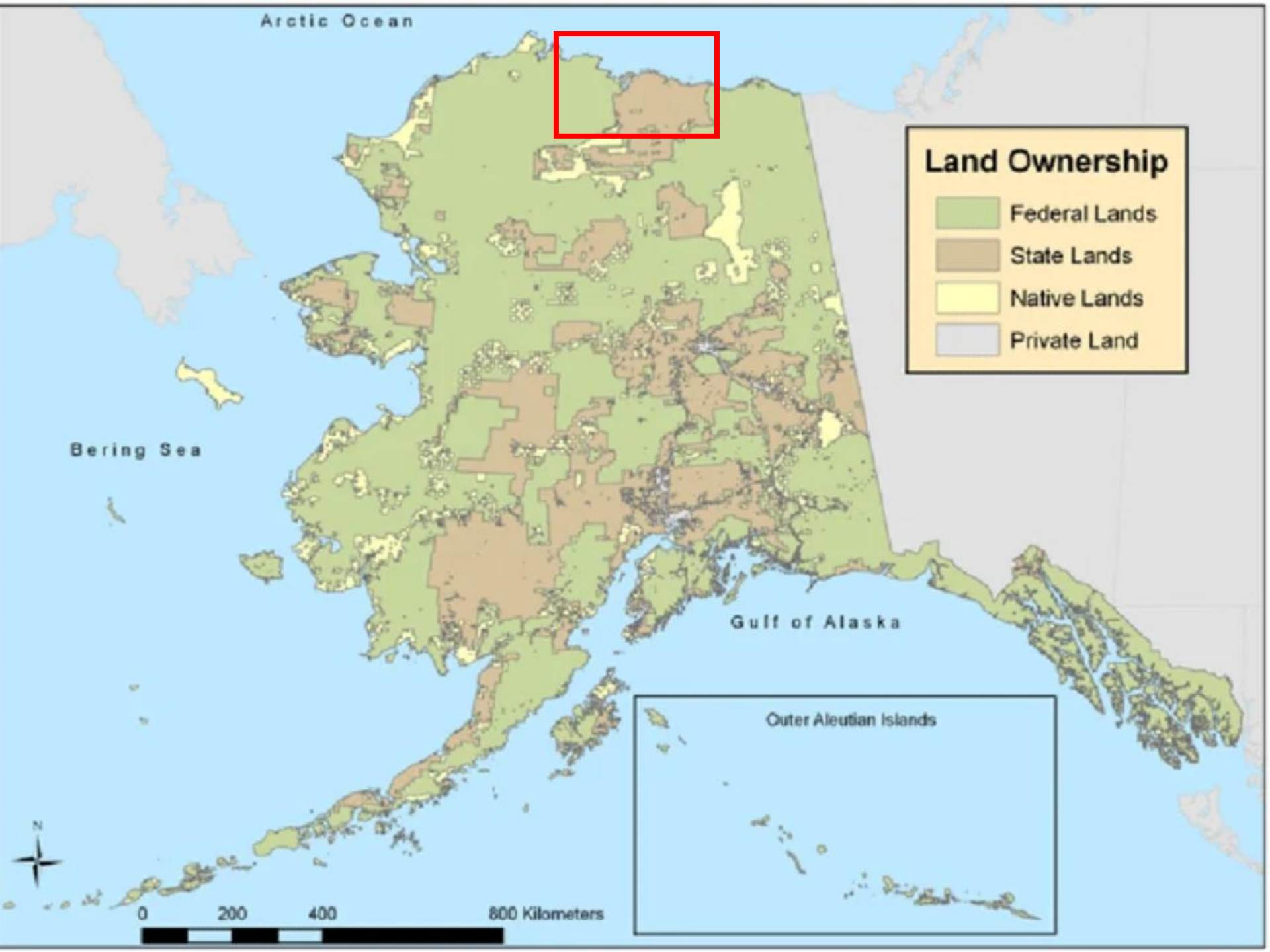
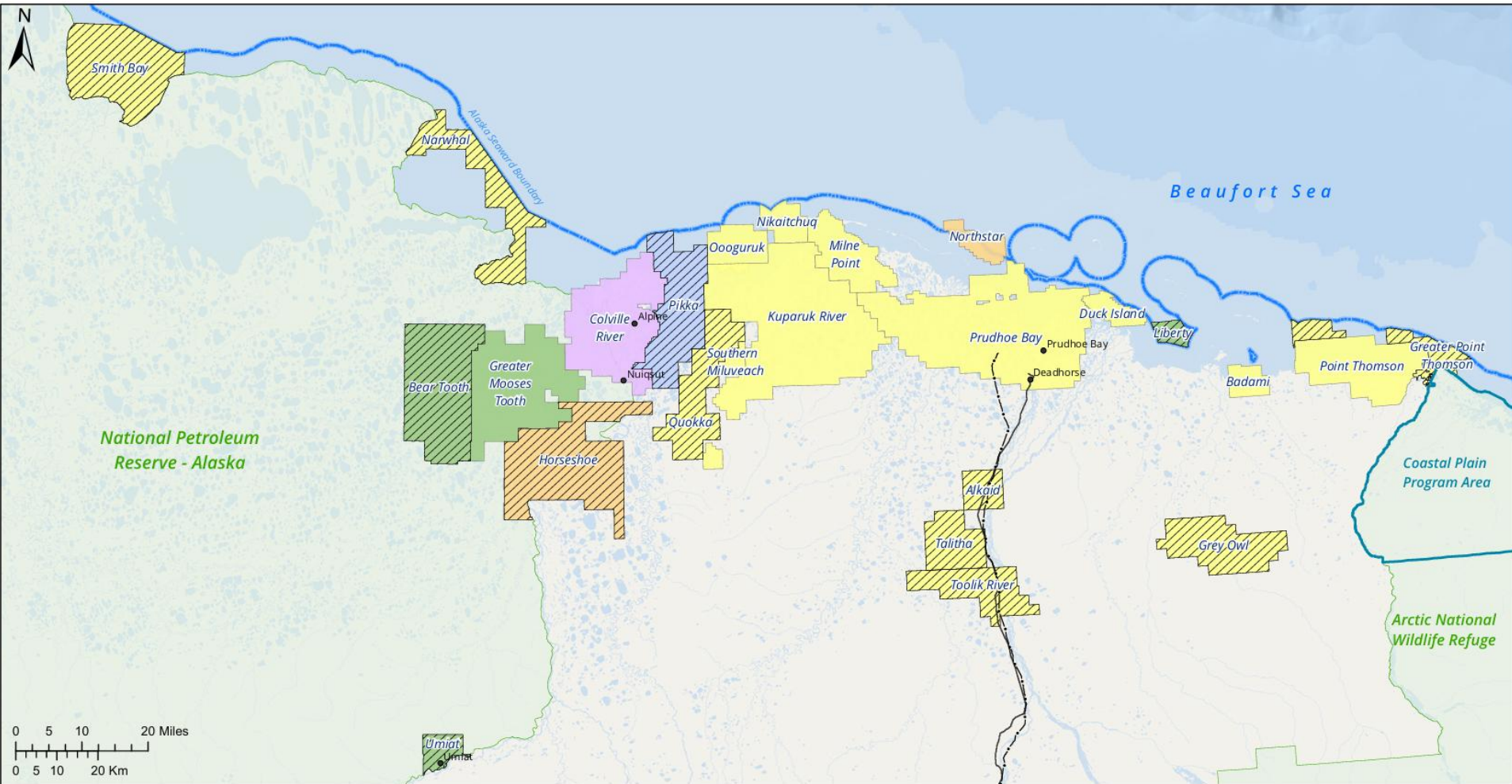

Unleashing Alaska's Extraordinary Resource Potential

Major Directives

Actions for Federal Agencies

- **Expedited Permitting:** Federal agencies are directed to speed up the permitting and leasing processes for resource development projects.
- **Rescinding Previous Restrictions:** The order revokes limitations imposed by the previous administration that hindered resource development in Alaska.

Focus Areas

- **Oil and Gas Development:** The order specifically targets the expansion of drilling activities, particularly in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge.
- **Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG):** It prioritizes the development and transportation of Alaska's LNG to other regions of the U.S. and allied nations.

ORDER NO. 3422

Subject: Unleashing Alaska's Extraordinary Resource Potential

Sec. 1. Purpose. This Order implements provisions of President Trump's January 20, 2025, Executive Order (EO) 14153, titled "Unleashing Alaska's Extraordinary Resource Potential," which directs the Secretary of the Interior to exercise all lawful authority and discretion available and take all necessary steps to unleash the State of Alaska's abundant and largely untapped supply of natural resources.

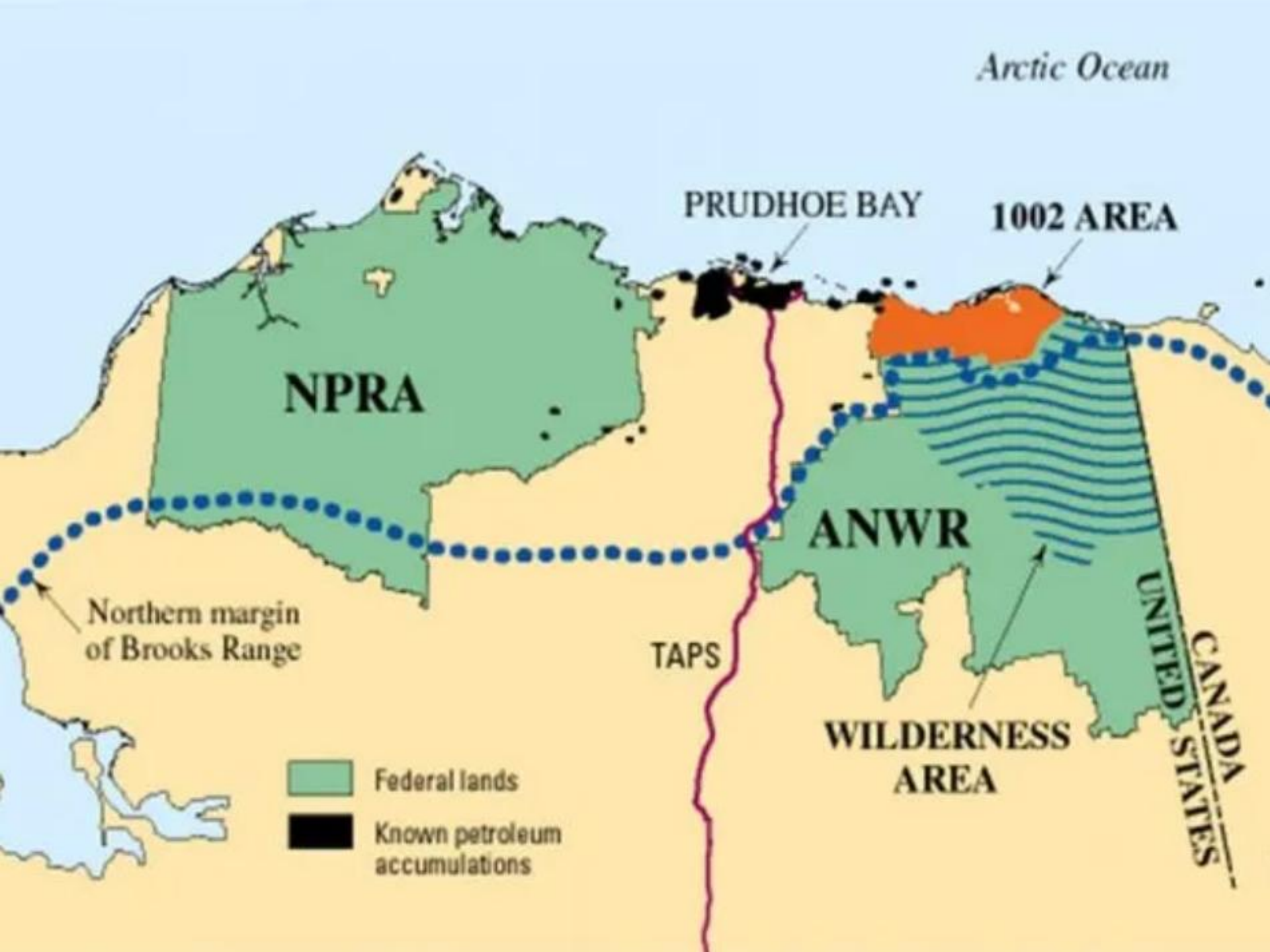
Sec. 4. Revocation of Secretary's Order. Secretary's Order (SO) 3401, dated June 1, 2021, titled "Comprehensive Analysis and Temporary Halt on All Activities in the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge (ANWR) Relating to the Coastal Plain Oil and Gas Leasing Program," is revoked. Policies, procedures, and guidance adopted to implement SO 3401 are hereby rescinded consistent with applicable laws, rules, and regulations.

Sec. 5. Reinstatement of Secretary's Order. SO 3352, dated May 31, 2017, titled "National Petroleum Reserve – Alaska," previously revoked by SO 3398, dated April 16, 2021, is reinstated. For purposes of the reinstated SO 3352, and in the absence of a Counselor to the Secretary for Energy Policy, the Assistant Secretary – Policy, Management and Budget will carry out the responsibilities assigned to the Energy Policy Counselor in that Order.

One Big Beautiful Bill

implications for oil and gas in Alaska

- ANWR: Mandates 4 lease sales in ANWR in 10 years
 - State share increases from 50 to 70% after 2034
- NPR-A: Mandates 5 lease sales in NPR-A in 10 years
 - State share increases from 50 to 70% in 10 years
- Cook Inlet: Mandates 6 lease sales in Cook Inlet in 10 years
- Streamlines NEPA regulatory process

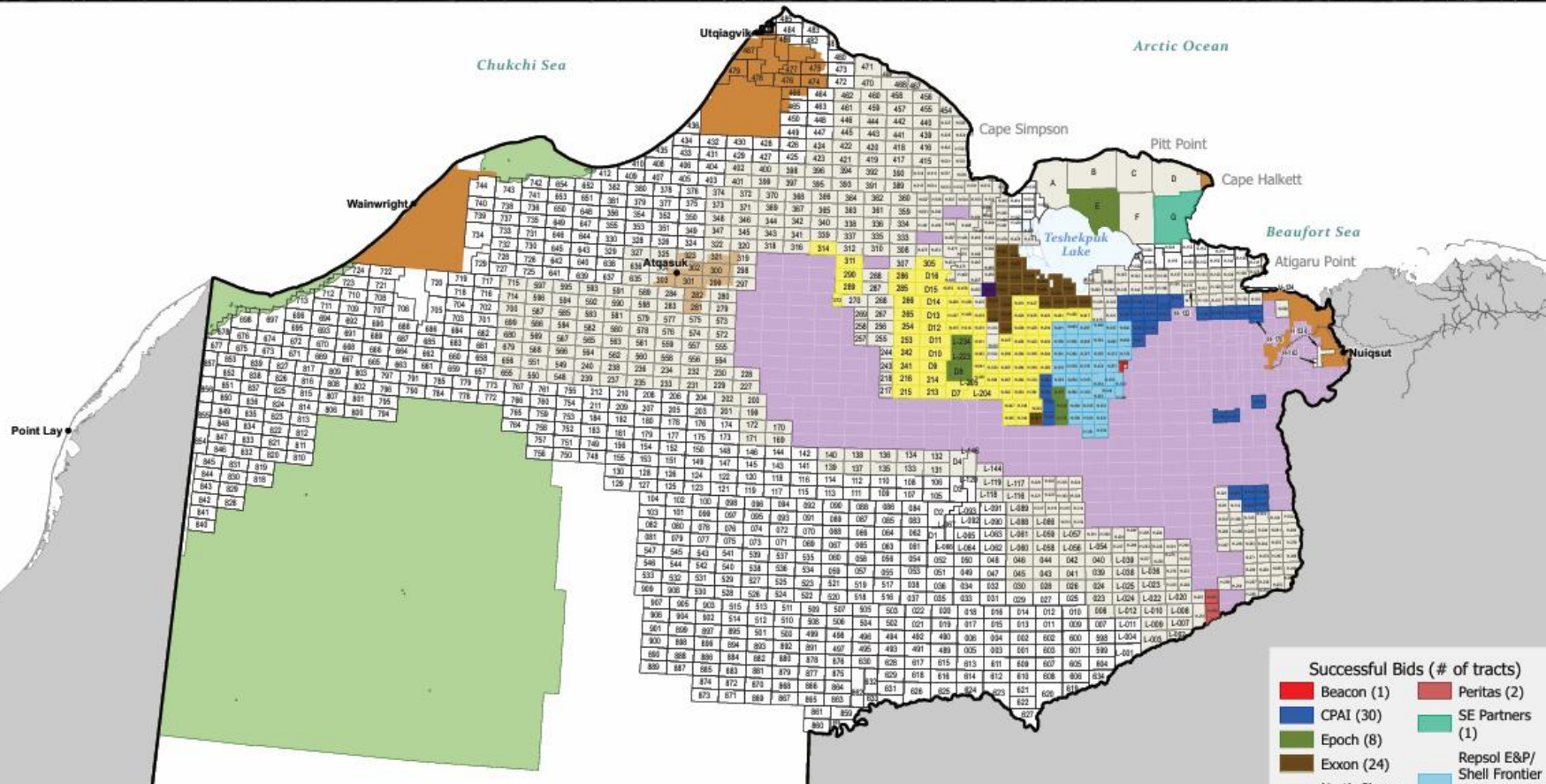




National Petroleum Reserve in Alaska, 2026 Lease Sale Results

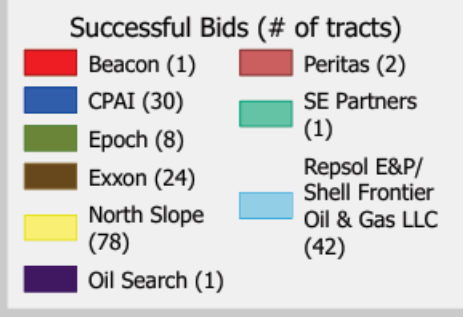
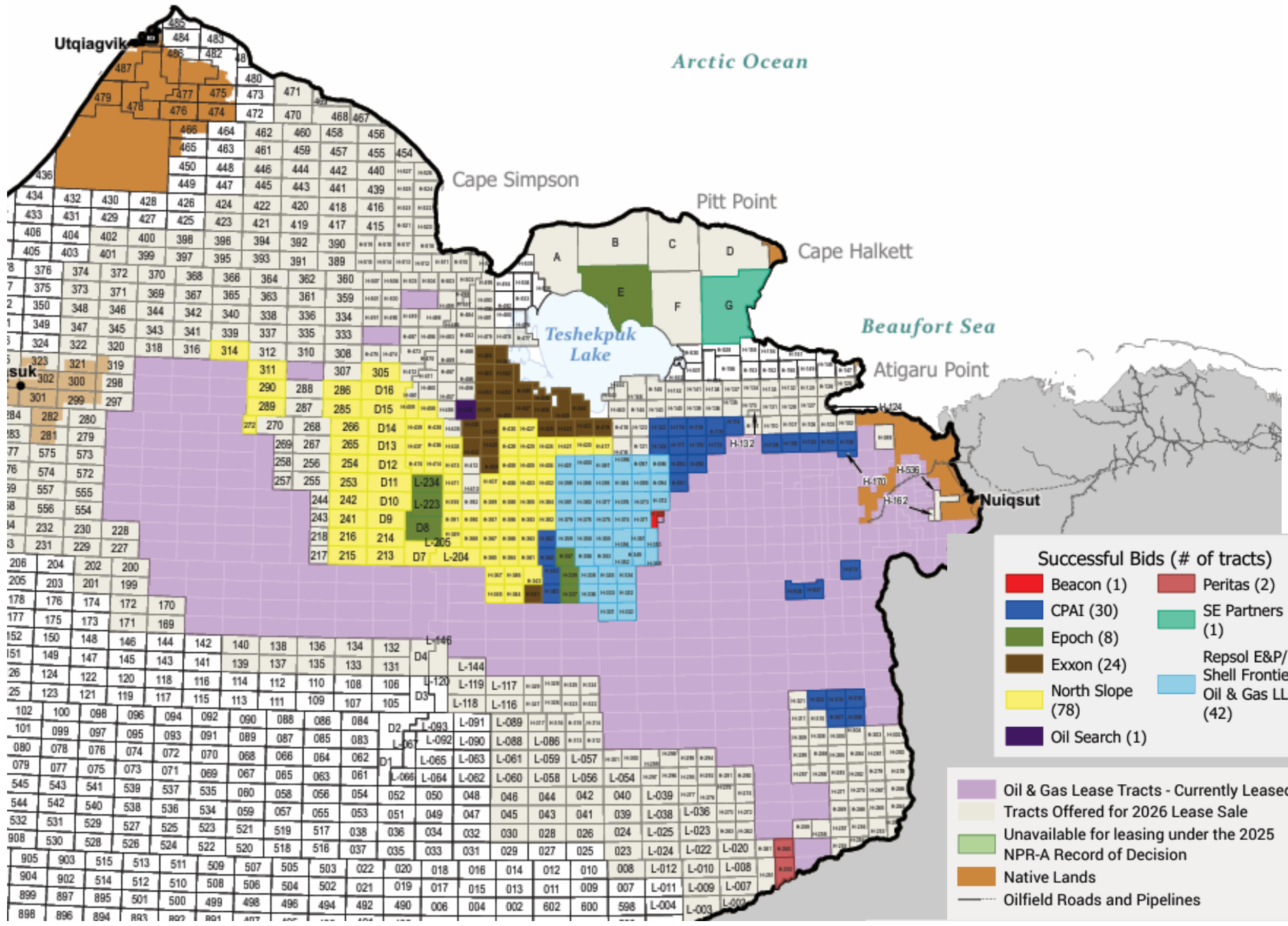

2017 Tax Cuts and Jobs Act

- Mandated 2 sales
- One sale held

2021 Secretary's Order 3401

- Halted all O&G activities in ANWR
- Rescinded leases from prior lease sale

2025 Federal Judge reinstates leases acquired in 2017

2025 Secretary's Order 3422 rescinds SO 3401

2026 Lease sale to be conducted as per One Big BB
