
- Revised in March 2020 to include additional data

2021 REPORT UPDATE

- Initiated by CRO
- Survey sent to states and provinces in July
- 32 states & 5 provinces responded
- IOGCC has compiled information received to date
- Asking States and provinces to review and confirm information by November 16

2021 UPDATE

Topics:

- Documented wells total and active
- Idle well numbers & requirements
- Tools to prevent wells from being orphaned
- Documented orphan wells numbers, operator status, land ownership
- Undocumented orphan wells
- Actions to prevent walls from becoming orphans
- Financial assurance
- Orphan wells plugged & restored
- Plugging funds & revenue sources
- Incentives and innovations

2021 UPDATE

Preliminary results:

- Final numbers not yet available pending verification by states & provinces
- Between 2018 and 2020:
 - Number of orphan wells plugged per year about doubled
 - > Net number of orphan wells increased
- Causes of increased numbers:
 - States verifying and documenting well status
 - Some operators going out of business

REGROW ACT (S.1076)

Revive Economic Growth and Reclaim Orphaned Wells Act of 2021

- Pending action in Congress
- Provisions:
 - Funding to states for orphan well plugging and restoration
 - Designates DOI to administer provisions
 - IOGCC partner with DOI for technical assistance
 - > IOGCC 2021 Update Report will be a primary source of information

REGROW ACT

- States have 45 days after Act is effective to submit intent to apply for formula grant
- IOGCC report will be key source of information
- IOGCC will ask states for updates on current number of orphan wells and add table to Report
- REMINDER: Please review current data & assure it is correct by Nov. 16
